Quilt finishes 64' $\times 76^{\prime \prime}$
120 Blocks: 6' x 6"

## Clever placement of simple two-patch blocks creates a delightful design with country appeal.

## Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances. Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus ${ }^{1 / 4} 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide).

Fabric A Cut (12) squares $67 / s^{\prime \prime} \times 67 / s^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric B Cut (12) squares $67 / s^{\prime \prime} \times 67 / s^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric C Cut (18) squares $67 / s^{\prime \prime} \times 67 / s^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric D Cut (18) squares $67 / s^{\prime \prime} \times 67 / s^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric E Cut (30) squares $67 / \mathrm{s}^{\prime \prime} \times 67 / \mathrm{s}^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric F Cut (18) squares $67 / \mathrm{s}^{\prime \prime} \times 67 / \mathrm{s}^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric G Cut (12) squares $67 / \mathrm{s}^{\prime \prime} \times 67 / \mathrm{s}^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric H Cut (2) borders $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 72^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut crosswise and pieced
Cut (2) borders $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 641 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut crosswise and pieced
Cut (8) strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF for binding
Backing Cut (2) panels $42^{\prime \prime} \times{ }^{\prime \prime} 2^{\prime \prime}$, pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

| Backing |  | $41 / 4$ yards | $7564-\mathrm{E}$ |

## Making and Assembling the Quilt

1. The blocks are made with half-square triangles (HST) that finish 6" square. Use your favorite method to make HST, or follow these directions. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all Fabric E 67/8" squares (Diagram 1). Place a marked square on a Fabric C square, right sides together. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on each side of the marked line; cut apart on the marked line. Press open to make 2 pieced blocks. Make 18 blocks like this.

2. Refer to the Quilt Diagram. To make the other blocks, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the lighter square in each pairing. Make 18 blocks (HST) with Fabric D and E squares, 18 blocks with Fabric D and F squares, 18 blocks with Fabric C and F squares, 12 blocks with Fabric B and G squares, 12 blocks with Fabric $A$ and $G$ squares, 12 blocks with Fabric A and E squares, and 12 blocks with Fabric B and E squares. You should have a total of 120 blocks.
3. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, position the blocks in 10 vertical rows of 12 blocks each, paying careful attention to the placement. Join the blocks in rows. Join the rows.
4. Sew the longer Fabric H borders to the sides. Sew the shorter borders to the top and bottom.

## Finishing the Quilt

5. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders and block patches. Quilt around the printed motifs in the blocks. Bind to finish the quilt.
