Quilt finishes 31" x 37"

Imagine strolling through a Paris neighborhood, stopping for an espresso at a sidewalk café. The imagery harks back to the famous Gene Kelly movie of the 1950s, with a nod to the ballet sequences in the movie. Prints with artists' palettes and brushes are part of the collection.

Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances. A fat $\frac{1}{8}$ is a 9" x 20"-22" cut of fabric. A fat $\frac{1}{4}$ is an 18" x 20"-22" cut. Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately $\frac{4}{2}$ " wide).

Fabric A	Fussy-cut (2) side borders 4" x 301/2",
	cut lengthwise
	Fussy-cut (2) top/bottom borders 4" x 241/2"
	cut crosswise from leftovers

Fabric B	Cut (2) t/b borders $5'' \times 24^{1/2}''$
	Cut (2) side borders 5" x 211/2"

Fabric C	Cut (2) squares $4\frac{3}{8}$ " x $4\frac{3}{8}$ ", cut in half
	diagonally to make 4 half-square triangles

Fabric D	Cut (2) squares 4% " x 4% ", cut in half
	diagonally to make 4 half-square triangles

Fabric E	Cut (1) 11" diameter circle (add turn-under
	allowance for hand appliqué)

 $\textbf{Fabric}\,\textbf{G}\quad \text{Cut}\, \text{Eiffel tower appliqu\'e}$

Fabric H Cut (2) side borders 2" x 18½" Cut (2) t/b borders 2" x 15½"

Fabric I Cut (4) strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for binding

Backing Cut (1) panel 37" x 43"

Making the Quilt


- 1. Draw an 11" circle on the paper side of paper-backed fusible web. Fuse the web to the backside of Fabric E. Cut out the circle. Following manufacturer's instructions, fuse the circle to the background Fabric F rectangle, referring to the quilt diagram for placement.
- 2. Trace the Eiffel tower motifs onto the fusible web.

 Fuse traced patterns to the wrong side of the fabric, keeping the orientation of the writing as shown.

 Cut out parts on the drawn lines. Following manufacturer's instructions, fuse the patches to the background, being certain there is no gap between the 2 patches. Finish the edges with a decorative machine stitch using contrasting thread, or use an invisible thread with a blind appliqué machine stitch.
- **3.** Referring to the quilt assembly, sew Fabric H borders to the sides and then top and bottom. Repeat to add Fabric B borders.
- **4.** Sew the longer Fabric A borders to the sides of the quilt.
- 5. Join a Fabric C and a Fabric D triangle to form a square. The square should measure 4" from edge to edge. Make 4 corner units like this. Sew units to ends of the shorter Fabric A borders, orienting the fabrics as shown. Sew to the top and bottom.


Finishing the Quilt

6. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around the appliqué and the borders. Quilt around the printed motifs as you wish. Bind to finish the quilt.


