# On the Terrace Quilt 

Introducing Andover Fabrics new collection: Anne's English Scrapbox by Di Ford-Hall Quilt designed by Janet Houts

Quilt finishes 84" x 93'
28 Block Y: $9^{\prime \prime} \times 9^{\prime \prime}$
28 Block Z: 9'x 9"
You'll feel like you have been transported to a charming English garden when making this lovely queen-size quilt. The various floral, geometric, and striped prints blend nicely in this muted palette. Simple blocks make this easy enough for an experienced beginner.

## Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances. A fat $1 / 8$ is a $9^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}-22^{\prime \prime}$ cut of fabric. A fat $1 / 4$ is an $18^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}-22^{\prime \prime}$ cut. Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide).

Fabric A Fussy-cut (4) squares $91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric B Fussy-cut (2) side borders $91 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 75^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ cut lengthwise Fussy-cut (2) top/bottom borders $91 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6612^{\prime \prime}$

Fabric C Cut (224) squares $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric D Cut (8) strips 2" x WOF, pieced to make the following:
(2) side borders $2^{\prime \prime} \times 721 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
(2) $t / b$ borders $2^{\prime \prime} \times 661 / 2$ "

Cut (4) squares $4^{\prime \prime}\left(3^{7} / s^{\prime \prime}\right)$, cut in half diagonally to make half-square triangles (Read Step 1 before cutting.)
Cut (2) squares $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric E Cut (9) strips $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF for binding
Cut (4) squares 4 " ( $3^{7} / s^{\prime \prime}$ ), cut in half diagonally to make 8 half-square triangles
Cut (2) squares $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric F Cut (56) squares $4^{\prime \prime}\left(3^{7} /^{\prime \prime}\right)$, cut in half diagonally to make 112 half-square triangles
Cut (28) squares $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
7Lt. From each:
Cut (16) squares $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
12 Med. From each:
Cut (4) squares 4 " $\left(3^{7 /} 8^{\prime \prime}\right)$, cut in half diagonally to make 8 half-square triangles
Cut (2) squares $3^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$

## Making the Quilt

1. The $Y$ blocks use half-square triangles (HST) that finish 3" square. Use your favorite method to make HST, or follow these directions. Cut squares $4^{\prime \prime}$ for HST that will be trimmed after stitching. If you prefer not to trim, cut squares $37 /^{\prime \prime}$. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each Fabric F 4" ( $3^{\left.7 / s^{\prime \prime}\right)}$ square (Diagram 1). Place a marked square on a medium square, right sides together. Sew $1 / 4$ " seam on each side of the marked line; cut apart on the marked line. Press open to make pieced HST. Trim to $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square if needed. Make HST using the Fabric D and Fabric E $4^{\prime \prime}\left(3^{7} s^{\prime \prime}\right)$ squares. Make 8 HST of each colorway.


Backing Cut (3) panels $34^{\prime \prime} \times 92^{\prime \prime}$, pieced horizontally to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

## On the Terrace Quilt

2. Referring to the Block $Y$ diagram, arrange patches as shown. Join the patches to make 3 rows, and then join the rows. Make 28 Block Y.
3. Referring to the Block Z diagram, arrange $3^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares as shown. Join to make 3 rows, and then join the rows. Make 28 Block Z.
4. The blocks are arranged alternately into 8 rows of 7 blocks each. Position the blocks as you wish, or follow the Quilt Diagram. Once you are satisfied with the placement, join the blocks into rows, and then join the rows.
5. Sew long Fabric D borders to the sides, and shorter borders to the top and bottom.
6. Sew long Fabric B borders to the sides of the quilt. Join Fabric A squares to ends of the shorter Fabric B borders. Sew to the top and bottom.

Finishing the Quilt
7. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders and block patches. Quilt around the printed motifs in the outer border. Bind to finish the quilt.
