## Be Witched Quilt

## Introducing Andover Fabrics new collection: Be Witched by Carol Eldridge Quilt designed by Heidi Pridemore

Quilt finishes 63" x 75 "
Block size: 12" x 12"

## Cutting Directions

Note: Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus $1 / 4$ " seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide).

Hint: Use your favorite method to make HST that finish 2" square or follow the directions here. If you prefer, cut the $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares for HST 3 ", and trim the HST after piecing.

Fabric A Fussy cut (1) $10^{1 / 2 "} \times 20^{1 / 2 "}$ large panel for the center.
Fussy cut (8) $6^{1 / 2 "} \times 10^{1 / 2 "}$ small panels for the blocks.

Fabric B Cut (48) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 10^{1 / 2 "}$ strips for the blocks. Cut (16) $1^{11 / 2 " ~} \times 81 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ strips for the blocks. Cut (32) $1 \frac{1}{1 / 2 "} \times 4 \frac{1}{2} / 2$ strips for the blocks. Cut (2) borders $31 / 2 " \times 20^{1 / 2}$ " strips for the center borders.
Cut (2) borders $21 / 2$ " x $161 / 2$ " strips for the center borders.

Fabric C Cut (8) $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{1 / 2}$ " strips for the blocks. Cut (2) $2 \frac{1}{2} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 52^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips for the borders.

Fabric D Fussy cut (4) $61 / 2 " \times 37$ " strips centering each on the heads stripe.

Fabric E Cut (32) $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6{ }^{1} / 2 "$ strips for the blocks. Cut (2) borders 2 " x $641 / 2$ " strips, cut crosswise and pieced.
Cut (2) borders 2" x 551⁄2" strips, cut crosswise and pieced.
Fabric $\mathbf{F}^{*}$ Cut (2) borders $41 / 2$ " $\times 67 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips, cut crosswise and pieced.
Cut (2) borders $41 / 2 " \times 63^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips, cut crosswise and pieced.
Fabric G Cut (8) $41 / 2$ " squares for the blocks.
Fabric H Cut (64) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares for the blocks.
Fabric I Cut (32) $2 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ squares for the blocks.
Cut (7) $2 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
*Backing Cut (2) panels 43" $\times 71^{\prime \prime}$, pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides for backing.

## Pieced Blocks

1. Sew one $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 41 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip to each side of one $41 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $G$ square to make one center row (Fig. 1). Press towards the Fabric G square. Sew one $11 / 2$ Fabric H square to each end of one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip to make the top row. Press towards the Fabric H square. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew the top row, center row and bottom rows together to make one $61 / 2$ " block center (Fig. 2). Repeat to make eight block centers total.

2. Sew one $21 / 2$ " $\times 61 / 2$ " Fabric E strip to each side of the block centers (Fig. 3). Press towards the Fabric E strip. Sew one $21 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I square to each end of one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E strip to make one top row. Press towards the Fabric E strip. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew the rows to the top and bottom of the block center (Fig. 4). Press towards the block center.
Repeat with the remaining block centers.

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3. Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric B strip to each side of one block center (Fig. 5). Press towards the Fabric B strip. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H square to each end of one $11 / 2$ " x $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip to make one top row. Press towards the Fabric B strip. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew the rows to the top and bottom of the block center (Fig. 6). Press towards the block center. Repeat with the remaining block centers to make eight $12^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieced blocks.

## Panel Blocks

4. Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of one $6^{1 / 2 "} \times 10^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A panel. Press towards Fabric B. Sew one $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 8^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A panel to make one $8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{1 / 2 "}$ Panel Block (Fig. 7). Press towards the Fabric B strips.
5. Center Panel: Sew one $31 / 2 " \times 20^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric B strip to each side of the $10^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A panel. Press towards the Fabric B strips. Sew one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 161 / 2$ "Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A panel (Fig. 8) to make the center panel.

6. Center one $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 37^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D strip on one side of the center panel. Start sewing the strip a $1 / 4 "$ from the top edge of the center panel and stop a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from the bottom edge (Fig. 9). DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the remaining three sides, making sure to stop and start $1 / 4$ " away from each end of the center panel.
7. To miter each corner, fold the quilt top on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 10). Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Fig. 10) draw a $45^{\circ}$ line out to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the $32^{1 / 2} \times 361 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ quilt top. Press the towards the Fabric D strips.


## Quilt Top

8. Sew one $21 / 2$ " $\times 12^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C strip to each side of two panel blocks for the side blocks (Fig. 11). Press towards Fabric C.
9. Sew one pieced block to the top and bottom of one side block to make one $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 361 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side block border (Fig. 12). Repeat to make a second side block border. Sew the borders to the quilt top. Press towards the center.

## Be Witched Quilt

10. Sew together three panel blocks and two pieced blocks, alternating them to make the top block border. Sew one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{1} / 2$ " Fabric $C$ strip to each side of the top border to make one $12^{1 / 2 "} \times 52^{1 / 2 "}$ top border (Fig. 13). Repeat to make a bottom border. Sew the borders to the quilt top. Press towards the borders.

11. Sew one $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 52^{1} / 2$ " Fabric $C$ strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top to make one $521 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 64^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Quilt top. Press towards the Fabric C strip.
12. Sew one 2 " $\times 641 / 2$ " Fabric $E$ to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2 " $\times 55^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric E strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press towards the Fabric E strips.
13. Sew one $41 / 2$ " $\times 67^{1 / 2}$ " Fabric F strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ $631 / 2$ " Fabric F strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press towards the F strips.

## Finishing the Quilt

14. Layer and quilt as desired. Sew the seven $2^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I strips together end-toend with $45^{\circ}$ seams to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Bind as desired.
