

# Carolina Crossing Quilt 

Introducing Andover Fabrics new collection: Carolina by Jo Morton Quilt designed and made by Candy Hargrove and machine quilted by Maggi Honeyman

Quilt finishes $621 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 621 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
208 4-Patch Blocks: 2" x 2"

As interesting as an inlaid puzzle, this wall quilt is made with quick techniques that result in easy-to-piece patchwork. Follow the Quilt Diagram for precise placement of the half-square triangles (HST), 4-Patch blocks, and little paisley squares to obtain the graphic diagonal design. The Civil War era prints - a mix of medium and small-scale paisleys, florals, and stripes - impart richness to the piece.

## Cutting Directions

Note: Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus $1 / 4 / 4$ seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide).

Hint: Use your favorite method to make HST that finish 2" square or follow the directions here. If you prefer, cut the $2^{7} / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares for HST $3^{\prime \prime}$, and trim the HST after piecing.
Fabric A Cut (2) borders $51 / 2$ " $\times 63$ ", cut lengthwise Cut (2) borders $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 53^{\prime \prime}$, cut lengthwise

Fabric B Cut (88) squares $2^{1} / 2$ " $\times 2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Cut (8) strips $1 \frac{1}{2}$ x WOF for 4 -Patch blocks

Fabric C Cut (88) squares $2^{1 / 2 "} \times 2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$
Cut (8) strips $1 \frac{1}{2} / \mathrm{x}$ WOF for 4 -Patch blocks
Fabric D Cut (26) squares $27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ for HST
*Fabric E Cut (48) squares $27 / 8$ " x $27 / 8 "$ for HST
Fabric F Cut (2) borders 2" x 53", cut crosswise and pieced Cut (2) borders $2 " \times 50^{\prime \prime}$, cut crosswise and pieced Cut (23) squares $2^{7 / 8 "} \times 2^{7 / 8 "}$ for HST

Fabric G Cut (22) squares $27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ for HST Cut 1 square 2" x 2 " for center

Fabric H Cut (8) strips $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for 4-Patch blocks
Fabric I Cut (8) strips $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF for 4-Patch blocks
Fabric J Cut (48) squares $27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ for HST
Fabric K Cut (7) strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF for binding Cut (25) squares $27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{7 / 8 "}$ for HST

Fabric L (4) sashes 2" $\times 241 / 22^{\prime \prime}$, cut crosswise
Backing Cut (2) panels $36^{\prime \prime} \times 71^{\prime \prime}$, pieced to fit quilt top with 4 " overlap on all sides.

## Making and Assembling the Quilt

1. Sew $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips in the combinations shown (Diagrams 1 and 2). Press the seam allowances toward the black print strips. Make 8 pieced bands of each combination. From each band, cut 26 segments each $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ wide. Cut a total of 208 segments of each color combination. Join 2 like segments to make a 4 -Patch block. It should measure $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square from edge to edge, including seam allowances. Make 104 blocks in each color.


## Quilt Assembly

2. To make the half-square triangles (HST), draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric E and Fabric J 27/8" squares (Diagram 3). Place a marked square on a Fabric D $2^{7 / 8 "}$ " square, right sides together. Sew a $1 / 4 "$ seam on each side of the marked line (Diagram 3); cut apart on marked line. Press open to make 2 pieced squares. They should measure $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ from edge to edge. Make a total of 102 red HST using Fabrics D and K combined with Fabrics E and J. Likewise, make 90 black HST using Fabrics F and G with Fabrics E and J (Diagram 4).
