36 Border Blocks: $3^{1 ⁄ 22^{\prime \prime}} \times 3 ½^{\prime \prime}$
The novelty prints in this fun collection give the impression of appliquéd motifs and a border pieced with small squares. However, you will know how easy the quilt is to construct. It is just the right size to snuggle under on a cold winter's night or to hang in a place of honor during the holidays. The red and green caterpillar comes from the beloved children's book written in 1969.

| Fabric G | border, blocks | 1 yard | $3476-\mathrm{R}$ |
| Fabric H | border, blocks | $13 / 4$ yards | A-T-White Lies |
| Backing |  | 5 yards | $7513-\mathrm{X}$ |

## Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances. Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately $43^{\prime \prime}$ wide).

Fabric A Cut (1) panel $21 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 42^{1 / 2 \prime}$ ", cut crosswise
Fabric B Fussy-cut (2) side borders $53 / \mathbf{s}^{\prime \prime} \times 63^{\prime \prime}$, cut crosswise and pieced, centering squares Fussy-cut (2) t/b borders $53 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 483 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, cut lengthwise and pieced, centering squares

Fabric C Fussy-cut (2) t/b borders $5^{\prime \prime}$ x $341 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut lengthwise, centering words
Fabric D Cut (2) side borders $33 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 743 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, cut crosswise and pieced
Cut (2) t/b borders $33 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 571 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, cut crosswise and pieced
Fabric E Cut (7) strips 21/4" x WOF for binding
Fabric F Cut (18) squares $43 / s^{\prime \prime} \times 43 / s^{\prime \prime}$, cut in half diagonally to make 36 half-square triangles
Fabric G Cut (2) side borders $1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 72^{3} / 4^{\prime \prime}$, cut crosswise and pieced
Cut (2) t/b borders $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 503 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, cut crosswise and pieced
Cut (2) side borders $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61^{\prime \prime}$, cut crosswise and pieced
Cut (2) t/b borders $112^{\prime \prime} \times 39^{\prime \prime}$, cut crosswise and pieced
Cut (9) squares $43 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 43 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, cut in half diagonally twice to make 36 quarter-square triangles
Fabric H Cut (2) side borders $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 491 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut lengthwise
Cut (2) side borders $13 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 581 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut lengthwise
Cut (2) t/b borders $13 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 37^{\prime \prime}$, cut lengthwise
Cut (9) squares $43 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 43 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, cut in half diagonally twice to make 36 quarter-square triangles
Cut (4) squares $4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$
Backing Cut (2) panels $32^{\prime \prime} \times 88^{\prime \prime}$, pieced to fit

## Making the Quilt

1. Refer to the quilt photograph when you fussy-cut the prints. To join crosswise Fabric B top/bottom border strips to make them long enough, sew 2 strips together so the print is continuous.
2. Referring to the Border Block diagram, sew a Fabric $G$ and Fabric $H$ triangle together. Press seam allowance toward Fabric G. Sew a Fabric F triangle to the edge. Press seam allowance open. Make 36 Border Blocks. Set aside.

3. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, join 12 Border Blocks side by side to make a pieced side border, turning the blocks as shown. Sew to the side of the quilt. Repeat for the other side. Sew 6 Border Blocks side by side to make the top border. Sew fabric H squares to the ends. Sew to the top. Repeat for the bottom.
4. Sew Fabric H $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders to the quilt's sides. Sew Fabric C borders to the top and bottom, keeping the words upright.
5. Sew Fabric H $13 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ borders to the sides, and then to the top and bottom.
6. Sew borders to the quilt in this order, sides on first: Fabric G 61" borders, then 48" borders; Fabric G $72^{\prime \prime}$ borders, then $50^{\prime \prime}$ borders; Fabric D 74" borders, then $56{ }^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders.

## Finishing

 the Quilt7. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt as desired. Bind to finish the quilt.
