Quilt finishes 74" x 90" 24 Blocks: 8" x 8"

Cutting Directions

Note: All measurements are cut sizes and include ½" seam allowances. Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus ½" seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

- **Fabric A** Cut (1) center $22\frac{1}{2}$ " x $38\frac{1}{2}$ ", cut lengthwise
- **Fabric B** Cut (7) strips 4½" x WOF, pieced to make the following:
 - (2) side borders 4½" x 72½"
 - (2) top/bottom borders 4½" x 56½"
- **Fabric C** Cut (7) strips 4½" x WOF, pieced to make the following:
 - (2) side borders 4½" x 72½"
 - (2) top/bottom borders 4½" x 56½"
- **Fabric D** Cut (96) rectangles 2½" x 47%" for Pinwheels
- Fabric E Cut (2) side borders 7½" x 58½", cut lengthwise Cut (2) top/bottom borders 7½" x 56½", cut lengthwise

Fabric F Cut (9) strips 2½" x WOF for binding **Note:** narrow black borders are listed in order needed.

Cut (15) strips 1½" x WOF, pieced to make the following:

- (2) side borders 1½" x 38½"
- (2) top/bottom borders 1½" x 24½"
- (2) side borders 1½" 56½"
- (2) top/bottom borders 1½" x 42½"
- (2) side borders 1½" x 72½"
- (2) top/bottom borders 1½" x 56½"

Cut (4) strips 1½" x 9½" for corner blocks Cut 4) strips 1½" x 8½" for corner blocks Cut (48) squares 2¾", cut in half diagonally to make 96 half-square triangles

- **Fabrics G, H** Cut (10) squares 47/8", cut in half diagonally to make 20 half-square triangles from each
- Fabrics I, J Cut (14) squares 47/8", cut in half diagonally to make 28 half-square triangles from each
- **Backing** Cut (2) panels 41" x 98", pieced to fit quilt top




Making and Assembling the Quilt

- 1. Referring to Diagram 1, position a Fabric D rectangle right side up on a cutting board. Mark a dot 2½" from the top left corner as shown. Draw a diagonal line from the bottom left corner to the dot. Trim along the drawn line and discard the corner. Position a Fabric F 27/8" triangle on top of the D, right sides together. Stitch along the angle as shown. Press open. Make 4 units like this for each Pinwheel block (96 total).
- 2. Referring to the Block Diagram, join the pieced units from Step 1 with Fabric G, H, I, and J 47/8" triangles into pieced squares. Join 4 like squares in the order shown. Sew an 81/2" black strip to one side of the block and sew a 91/2" black strip to the adjacent side. Make 5 blocks each with Fabrics G and H. Make 7 blocks each with Fabrics I and J.
- 3. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, sew the black borders to the quilt center, following the order listed in Fabric F cutting list. Join blocks in 4 rows of 5 blocks each, referring to the order shown in the diagram. Sew block rows to the sides, and then to the top and bottom, matching seams. Four remaining blocks are used in the outer border.
- **4.** Referring to the Quilt Diagram and the cutting list above, sew borders in this order: black borders (side, top/bottom), and then Fabric E borders (side, t/b).
- 5. Join the Fabric C, F, and B borders of the same length together as shown. Sew longer border units to the sides. Sew a block to each end of the 56½" C/F/B border units. Sew to the top and bottom, matching seams.

Finishing the Quilt

6. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders and block patches. Quilt around the printed motifs in the center and borders as desired. Bind to finish the quilt.






Block Diagram
