## Quilt finished 50' x 68"

Chillingsworth is on display in this whimsical Halloween quilt. The basic applique adds an elegant touch to "frame" the square panels.

## Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42 " wide).

## Fabric A

Fussy cut (2) panels approximately $20^{1 / 2 "} \times 20^{1 / 2 "}$ square.

## Fabric B

Cut (2) 3 " $\times 25^{1 / 2 "}$ strips
Cut (1) 3 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut into
(2) 3 " $\times 20^{1 / 2 " ~}$ strips.

Cut (4) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew together and cut (2) 2 " x 68 1/2" strips.
Cut (6) $21 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF strips for the binding.

## Fabric C

See instructions to cut (8) Frame Templates

## Fabric D

Cut (2) $51 / 2$ " $\times 361 / 2$ " strips from the WOF.
Cut (1) $101 / 2 " \times 361 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips from the WOF.
Cut (4) $61 / 2 " \times 241 / 2 "$ strips from the LOF.

## Fabric E

Cut (2) $61 / 2 " \times 681 / 2 "$ strips from the LOF.

## Backing

Cut (2) 58 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 58 " $\times 76$ " backing.

## Making the Quilt

## 1. Block Assembly:

Sew one 3" x $201 / 1 / 2$ " Fabric B strip to each side of one $201 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A square. Sew one 3 " x $25^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the $201 / 2$ " Fabric A square to make one Panel Unit (Diagram 1). Trim the panel unit to measure $241 / 2$ " $\times 241 / 2$ " square. Repeat to make a second panel unit.
2. Sew one $61 / 2 " \times 24^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric D strip to each side of one panel unit. Repeat with the second panel unit. Sew one panel unit to the top of the $101 / 2$ " $\times 361 / 2$ " Fabric D strip. Sew one panel unit to the bottom of the $101 / 2$ " $\times 361 / 2$ " Fabric D strip to make the quilt top. Sew one $5^{1 / 2 "} \times 36^{1 / 2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top (Diagram 2).
3. Enlarge the template $400 \%$.
4. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace eight frame templates onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about $1 / 8$ " outside the drawn lines.

5. Press each template onto the wrong side of Fabric C, paying attention to the direction of the print. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
6. Refer to Diagram 3 to arrange and press the four frame units around each panel unit as shown.
7. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch.

## Quilt Top:

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)
8. Sew one $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 681 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to each side of the quilt top.
9. Sew one $2 " \times 681 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the quilt top.

## Finishing the Quilt

10. Layer and quilt as desired.
11. Sew the (8) $2 \frac{1}{2} / 2 \times$ WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
12. Bind as desired.
