## Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches.
All measurements are cut sizes and include $14^{1 / \prime}$ seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide).

Fabric A Cut (20) squares $47 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 47 / s^{\prime \prime}$, cut in half diagonally to make 40 half-square triangles

Fabric B Cut (2) side borders $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 641 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut crosswise and pieced Cut (2) top/bottom borders $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 62^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}}$, cut crosswise and pieced

Fabric C Cut (20) squares $47 / s^{\prime \prime} \times 47 / s^{\prime \prime}$, cut in half diagonally to make 40 half-square triangles

Fabric D Cut (2) side borders $4 \frac{1}{2} /^{\prime \prime} \times 661^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}}$, cut crosswise and pieced Cut (2) t/b borders $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 621 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut crosswise and pieced

Fabric E Cut (20) squares $47 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$, cut in half diagonally to make 40 half-square triangles
Cut (4) squares $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}}$
Fabric F Cut (8) strips $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF for binding
Cut (20) squares $47 / s^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{7 / s^{\prime \prime}}$, cut in half diagonally to make 40 half-square triangles

Fabric G Cut (20) squares $87 / \mathrm{s}^{\prime \prime} \times 87 / \mathrm{s}^{\prime \prime}$, cut in half diagonally to make 40 half-square triangles

Fabric H Cut (20) squares $87 / s^{\prime \prime} \times 87 / s^{\prime \prime}$, cut in half diagonally to make 40 half-square triangles

Backing Cut (2) panels $41^{\prime \prime} \times 78^{\prime \prime}$, pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

Fabric G blocks $11 / 2$ yards $8113-\mathrm{P}$
Fabric H blocks $11 / 2$ yards $8114-\mathrm{K}$
Backing $\quad 4112$ yards $\quad 8113-\mathrm{K}$

## Making the Quilt

1. Referring to the Block Y Diagram, join 2 Fabric A and 2 Fabric F $47 / \mathbf{s}^{\prime \prime}$ triangles to form a diagonal row. Sew a Fabric G $87 / \mathbf{8}^{\prime \prime}$ triangle to each side. Make 20 blocks like this.


Block Y - Make 20
2. Referring to the Block Z Diagram, join 2 Fabric C and 2 Fabric E triangles to make the pieced row. Sew a Fabric H triangle to each side. Make 20 blocks like this.


## Crossing the Pond Quilt

3. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, arrange the blocks in alternating order as shown. Join 5 blocks to make a row. Make 8 rows. Join the rows.
4. Sew longer Fabric B borders to the sides of the quilt. Sew shorter borders to top and bottom.
5. Sew longer Fabric D borders to the sides. Sew Fabric E $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares to ends of remaining Fabric D borders. Sew to the top and bottom.

Finishing the Quilt
6. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders and block patches. Quilt around the printed motifs in the outer border. Bind to finish the quilt.
