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Quilt finishes 761/2" x 803/4"
Pieced Blocks: $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ square (finished)

## Cutting Directions

Note: Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus $1 / 4$ " seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A Cut one $31^{\prime} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strip.
Sub-cut into two $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Cut three $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
Fabric B Cut one $31 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 42$ " strip.
Sub-cut into ten $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Cut six $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
Fabric C Cut two $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42$ " strips.
Sub-cut into eighteen $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Cut eight $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
Fabric D Cut two $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
Sub-cut into thirteen $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Cut four $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 42$ " strips.
Fabric E Cut two $31 / 2$ " x $42^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
Sub-cut into thirteen $3 \not 1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Cut eight $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
Fabric F Cut three $31^{1 / 2 "} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Sub-cut into thirty-four $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Cut fifteen $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
Fabric G Cut two $3 \not 1^{\prime \prime}{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
Sub-cut into twenty-one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Cut seven $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
Fabric H Cut two $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42$ " strips.
Sub-cut into twenty-one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Cut ten $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips.

Fabric I Cut five $3^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
Sub-cut into fifty $3^{1 / 2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Cut eighteen $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 42$ " strips.
Fabric J Cut five $3^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
Sub-cut into fifty-eight $3^{11 / 2 "}$ squares.
Cut twenty-one $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 42$ " strips.
Fabric K Cut six $3^{1 / 2 "} \times 42$ " strips.
Sub-cut into sixty-six $3^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Cut twenty-four $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 42 " strips.
Fabric L Cut seven $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42$ " strips.
Sub-cut into seventy-four $3^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Cut eleven $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 42 " strips.
Cut eight $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42$ " strips for the binding.
Backing Cut three 85 " x 42" strips.
Sew the strips together and trim to make one 85 " x 89 " backing piece.

## 9-Patch Blocks

1. Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42$ " Fabric B strip to each side of one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42$ " Fabric A strip to make one middle unit strip set (Fig. 1).
2. Cut the middle unit strip set into six $1 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ middle units across the sewn seams (Fig. 2).
3. Sew one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A strip to each side of one $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip to make one top/bottom strip set (Fig. 3).
4. Cut the top/bottom strip set into twelve $11 / 2$ " units across the sewn seams (Fig. 4).
5. Follow Figure 5 to sew one top/bottom unit to the top and bottom of one middle unit to make one $3^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{A} / \mathrm{B} 9$-patch block. Repeat to make six A/B 9-patch blocks.
6. Repeat Steps 1 and 2 to make fourteen B/C 9-patch blocks. You will need to make one strip set for the top and bottom units (28) and one strip set for the middle units (14).
7. Repeat Steps 1 and 2 to make twenty-two C/D 9-patch blocks. You will need to make two strip sets for the top and bottom units (44) and one strip set for the middle units (22).
8. Repeat Steps 1 and 2 to make thirty E/F 9-patch blocks. You will need to make three strip sets for the top and bottom units (60) and two strip sets for the middle units (30).
9. Repeat Steps 1 and 2 to make thirty-eight F/G 9-patch blocks. You will need to make three strip sets for the top and bottom units (76) and two strip sets for the middle units (38).
10. Repeat Steps 1 and 2 to make forty-six H/I 9-patch blocks. You will need to make four strip sets for the top and bottom units (92) and two strip sets for the middle units (46).
11. Repeat Steps 1 and 2 to make fifty-four I/J 9-patch blocks. You will need to make four strip sets for the top and bottom units (108) and two strip sets for the middle units (54).
12. Repeat Steps 1 and 2 to make sixty-two J/K 9-patch blocks. You will need to make five strip sets for the top and bottom units (124) and three strip sets for the middle units (62).
13. Repeat Steps 1 and 2 to make seventy K/L 9-patch blocks. You will need to make five strip sets for the top and bottom units (140) and three strip sets for the middle units (70).

## Quilt Top

14. Refer to the quilt photo and quilt top layout on page 4 for block placement to sew together the assorted 9 -patch blocks and assorted $31 / 2$ " squares in diagonal rows.
15. Sew the diagonal rows together to make the quilt top. Square up the quilt top by trimming the Fabric L squares.

## Finishing the Quilt

16. Layer and quilt as desired. Sew the eight $2^{1 / 2} \times \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric L strips together end-to-end with a $45^{\circ}$ seams to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Bind as desired.
