Quilt finishes 57" x 69"

The exotic prints bring attention to this easy strippy quilt. The rainbow order of the fabrics is at once calming and interesting. Placing the lightest fabrics in the middle draws the viewer's eyes to the center.

Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include 1/4" seam allowances. A fat 1/4 is an 18" x 20"-22" cut. Sashes are cut the exact lengths required plus 1/4" seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A

Cut (7) strips 2½" x WOF for binding Cut (5) rectangles 3½" x 9½"

Fabric B

Cut (6) sashes 3½" x 69½", cut lengthwise

22 Fat 1/4's

From each: Cut (5) rectangles $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ "

Backing

Cut (2) panels 39" x 65", pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides



Making the Quilt

- 1. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, join 23 rectangles, one of each print, to make a vertical column. Feel free to arrange the fabrics in any order you desire or as shown. Make 5 columns alike. Press the seam allowances in one direction.
- **2.** Sew the columns between the 6 sashes, being careful to keep the patches aligned between columns. Press the seam allowances toward the sashes.

Finishing the Quilt

3. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around the patches. Quilt around the printed motifs in the rectangles. Quilt the sashes as you wish. Bind to finish the quilt.



Quilt Diagram


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All fabrics are used in quilt pattern. Fabrics shown are 10% of actual size.



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
