

# Flannel Dino Quilt 

## Introducing Andover Fabrics new collection: Flannel Dino by MakowerUK

 Quilt designed by Janet HoutsQuilt finishes: $561 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 66^{\prime \prime}$
10 Pieced Blocks: 8" x $8 "$

Dinosaur lovers of all ages will smile at the lovable creatures in this brightly multihued quilt. The novelty prints do much of the work-the "pieced" outer side borders are printed patchwork, and the large center panel will look like applique once it is quilted. The piecing is easy enough that you may want to make more than one!

## Cutting Directions

Note: Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus $1 / 4$ " seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).
Fabric A Fussy-cut 1 panel $21^{\prime \prime} \times 301 / 2 "$ (includes seam allowances)

Fabric B Fussy-cut (2) borders $8 \frac{1}{2} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 39 "$, cut lengthwise
Fabric D Cut (2) borders $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 481^{\prime 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut lengthwise
Fabric C Cut (2) panels 38" x 65", pieced to fit quilt top with 4 " overlap on all sides.

Fabric E Fussy-cut (4) squares $81 / 2 " \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric F Cut (10) squares $8^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$
Fabric G Cut (4) squares $81 / 2 "$ x $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric H Cut (14) sashes 2" x $8^{1 / 2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ (cut striped print perpendicular to long edge)
Fabric I Cut (40) squares $41 / 2$ " $\times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric J Cut (2) top/bottom borders $1 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 57$ ", cut crosswise and pieced
Cut (2) side borders $1 \frac{1}{2} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 48^{1 / 2 "}$ ", cut crosswise and pieced
Cut (4) sashes $1^{1 / 2 "}$ x $81 / 22^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric K Cut (7) strips $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for binding
Cut (2) top/bottom borders $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 39$ ", cut crosswise and pieced
Cut (2) side borders $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 30^{1 / 2 "}$
Cut (4) sashes $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 8^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$

Fabric A quilt center

Fabric B border
Fabric C backing
Fabric D border
Fabric E corner blocks
Fabric F blocks
Fabric G corner blocks
Fabric H sashes
Fabric I blocks
Fabric J border
Fabric K border, binding

## Making and Assembling the Quilt

1. To make the square-in-a-square blocks, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each Fabric I $41 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square. Referring to Diagram 1, place a marked square on a Fabric F $81 / 2$ " square, right sides together, aligning raw edges at one corner. Stitch on the drawn line; trim away and discard the excess fabric. Press open. Repeat on each corner (Diagram 2), watching orientation of the stitching lines. Make a total of 10 blocks.

2. Refer to the Quilt Diagram throughout the assembly. Sew the $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 30^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric K borders to the sides of the fussy-cut center panel. Join 3 pieced blocks with 4 Fabric H sashes to make a side border. Repeat. Sew to the sides of the quilt. Sew the $11 / 2 " \times 39$ " Fabric K borders to the top and bottom.
3. Join 2 pieced blocks with 3 striped sashes. Sew a Fabric K sash to each end, and then sew a Fabric E square to each end, keeping all dino prints oriented correctly. Sew to the top of the quilt. Repeat for the bottom, being careful to keep the printed dinos upright.

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4. Sew the $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 48^{1 / 2}$ " Fabric J borders to one edge of the $8^{1 / 2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ x $481 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D borders. Sew pieced borders to the sides of the quilt with the yellow border touching the quilt as shown. Sew the $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 57^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric J borders to the top and bottom.
5. Sew a Fabric J sash and a Fabric $G$ square to each end of a Fabric B panel in the order shown. Sew to the top of the quilt. Repeat for the bottom, orienting the dino panel upright.

## Finishing the Quilt

6. Layer the quilt with batting and backing. Quilt in the ditch around borders and block patches. Quilt around the printed motifs in the center panel and in the Fabric B and Fabric E patches. Bind with Fabric K to finish the quilt.
