# Flower Press Quilt 

Introducing Andover Fabrics new collection: FLOWER PRESS by Renée Nanneman Quilt designed by Renée Nanneman

Quilt finishes 81' x 99'" 99 Blocks: 9' x 9"

An homage to quilts from the past, this queen-size quilt will look charming in nearly any décor. The subtle mix of scrappy prints is more controlled in the red version. The scale and number of blocks are best suited to someone with some piecing experience.

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide).

## Cutting Directions for Red Quilt

## Fabric A

Cut (198) strips $114^{\prime \prime} \times 7^{\prime \prime}$
Cut (198) strips $114^{\prime \prime} \times 5{ }^{1 / 2 \prime} 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Fabric B

Cut (99) squares $4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$ for block centers
Cut (38) squares $3^{1 / 4^{\prime \prime}} \times 3^{1 / 4^{\prime \prime}}$, cut in half diagonally

## Fabric C

Cut (594) squares $31^{1 / 4^{\prime \prime}} \times 31 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, cut in half diagonally

## Fabric D

Cut (10) strips $2^{1 / 2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF for binding
Cut (32) squares $3^{1 / 2 \prime} \times 3^{112 \prime} 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut in half diagonally

## 2 Med. Red From each:

Cut (32) squares $3^{1 / 2 \prime} \times 3^{112} 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut in half diagonally

## 3 Med. Red From each:

Cut (34) squares $3^{11 / 2^{\prime \prime}} \times 3^{112} 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut in half diagonally

## 4 Lt. Prints From each:

Cut (40) squares $31 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3114^{\prime \prime}$, cut in half diagonally (read Step 2)

## Backing

Cut (3) panels $36^{\prime \prime}$ x $89^{\prime \prime}$, pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

## Cutting Directions for Blue Quilt

## Fabric A

Cut (198) strips $11 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 7^{\prime \prime}$
Cut (198) strips $11 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Fabric B

Cut (10) strips $2^{1 / 2 \prime} \times$ WOF for binding
Cut (32) squares $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3{ }^{1 / 2} 1^{\prime \prime}$, cut in half diagonally
Cut (32) squares $31^{1 / 4^{\prime \prime}} \times 33^{1 / 4^{\prime \prime}}$, cut in half diagonally

## 3 Med. Blue

Cut (34) squares $3^{11 / 2^{\prime \prime}} \times 3^{112} 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut in half diagonally Cut (34) squares $31 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 314^{\prime \prime}$, cut in half diagonally

## 2 Med. Blue

Cut (32) squares $3^{11 / 2^{\prime \prime}} \times 3^{112} 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut in half diagonally
Cut (32) squares $31 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3{ }^{114^{\prime \prime}}$, cut in half diagonally

## 3 Lt. Prints From each:

Cut (16) squares $4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$ for block centers Cut (102) squares $31^{1 / 4^{\prime \prime}} \times 3{ }^{1 / 4^{\prime \prime}}$, cut in half diagonally

## 3 Lt. Prints From each:

Cut (17) squares 4 " $\times 4$ " for block centers
Cut (96) squares $3{ }^{1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times} \times 3^{114^{\prime \prime}}$, cut in half diagonally

## Backing

Cut (3) panels $36^{\prime \prime} \times 89^{\prime \prime}$, pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

## Making the Red or Blue Quilt

[information in brackets is for the Blue Quilt]

1. Make a "test" block before cutting all patches to be certain that your cutting and sewing result in a $91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (unfinished size) block. If your block is a slightly different size, it will still work as long as all 99 blocks are the same size.

Referring to the block diagram, sew a medium red [medium blue] $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ triangle to each side of a Fabric B [light blue print] $4^{\prime \prime}$ square. Sew a Fabric A $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip


Red Block - Make 99


Blue Block - Make 99 to opposite sides of the center unit. Sew Fabric A 7" strips to remaining sides to make the center unit.
2. Red quilt: For one block you need 12 Fabric C $31 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ triangles and 4 light $31 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ triangles. To make the pieced corner units, sew 3 Fabric C triangles to the sides of a light triangle as shown. Make 4 corner units alike.
[Blue quilt: For one block you need 12 light $31 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ triangles from the same print and 4 medium blue triangles. Sew 3 light triangles to the sides of a medium blue triangle as shown. Make 4 corner units alike.]

Sew a corner unit to each side of the center unit to make a block. If necessary, trim the block to $91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square, or whatever size is best for your block. Repeat these steps to make 99 blocks.
3. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, join 9 blocks to make a horizontal row. Make 11 rows. Join the rows.

## Finishing the Quilt

4. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around block patches. Bind to finish the quilt.
