

# Garden Fresh Quilt 

Introducing Andover Fabrics new collection: Garden Fresh Quilt designed by Gail Kessler and machine quilted by Barbara Persing

## Welcome

Oh, so fast! This adorable quilt, perfect for any kitchen or garden room goes together in a flash. Celebrate your vegetable garden (or just vegetables) with this fun fabric collection and sew a loving gift for your favorite gardener.
Notice that the outer border strips are cut centered on the vegetable stripe with the light green strip visible on both sides. Cut strips carefully centering veggies to get the same look.
Feel free to cut the $7 \frac{1}{2}$ " vegetable panel squares centering any vegetable and arrange them in the quilt as you please.

Fabric Requirements and Cutting Directions
4136-G $3 / 4$ yard Vegetable Squares (panels)
Cut (9) $\quad 71 / 2^{\prime}$ squares, centered on vegetable panels
4145-G 3/8 yard Green/White Dotted Loops Print (blocks)
Cut (4) $2^{7 / 8 "}$ squares
Cut (2) $27 / 8 " \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric strips
*4143-G 11/s yards Green/Multicolor Dot Print (blocks, inner border)
Cut (16) $2^{7} / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Cut (6) $27 / 8 " \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric strips
Cut (4) $271 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 351 / 2 "$ strips
4141-C $1 / 4$ yard Gray Bubble Print (Nine-Patch blocks, inner border corner squares)
Cut (16) $2^{77 / 8}$ squares


4138-G $13 / 8$ yards White/Green Vegetable Border Stripe (outer border)
Cut (4) $\quad 61 / 2 " \times 40^{1 / 4} 4^{\prime \prime}$ strips lengthwise, centered on large vegetable stripe
4139-G $3 / 8$ yard Light Green/Multicolor Vegetable Print (outer border corners)
Cut (4) $\quad 61 / 2$ " squares
*Additional yardage needed for binding or backing (see below).

## *4140-G 3½ yards Light Green/Green Lattice Print (backing)

Cut and piece to fit quilt top with 4 " overlap on all sides.

## *4143-G $\quad 5 / 8$ yard Green/Multicolor Dot (binding)

Cut (6) $21 / 2$ "" $x$ width of fabric strips

## Making the Blocks and Pieced Border

1. Referring to Diagram A, stitch 3 rows using 1 green/white dotted loop $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square, 4 green/multicolor dot $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares, 3 gray bubble, and 1 lattice print $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square. Sew rows together to make NinePatch block. Trim, if needed, to $71^{\prime} 2^{\prime \prime}$. Make 4 .
2. Stitch together 2 green/multicolor dot and 1 lattice width of fabric strips to make strip set (Diagram B). Make 1. Cut 4 segments $71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide to make Rail Fence blocks. In same manner, make 2 strip sets using 2 green/multicolor dot width of fabric strips and 1 green/white dotted loop width of fabric strip each. Cut 8 segments $71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide to make Rail Fence blocks.

## Assembling the Quilt

Please refer to Assembly Diagram and quilt photo throughout assembly. Watch orientation of blocks and panel squares carefully.
3. Stitch 2 rows using 3 vegetable panels and 2 green/loop Rail Fence blocks, alternating. Sew 2 rows using 2 green/loop Rail Fence blocks, 2 Nine-Patch blocks, and 1 green/lattice Rail Fence block. Sew 1 row using 3 vegetable panels and 2 green/lattice Rail Fence blocks. Stitch rows together to make quilt center.
