## Planning

Quilt finishes 64" x 84"

## Fabric Requirements \& Cutting Directions

Note: A fat $1 / 8$ th is a $9 " \times 21 "-22^{\prime \prime}$ cut of fabric. Borders and sashes are cut the exact lengths required plus $1 / 4$ " seam allowances.

## 3135-N 11/8 yards Dark Brown Tic Tac (inner border, border corners, binding)

Cut (2) borders $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 72^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut crosswise and pieced
Cut (2) borders $1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 54^{1} 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut crosswise and pieced
Cut (8) strips $2^{1 / 2} \times \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric for binding
Cut (4) squares $5^{1 / 2 "} \times 5^{1 / 2 "}$ for border corners
4936-T $\quad 2^{1 ⁄ 2}$ yards Garden Whimsy Stripe (sashes, outer border)
Cut (2) borders $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 74^{1 / 2}$ ", fussy cut lengthwise
Cut (2) borders $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 54 \frac{1}{2}$ ", fussy cut lengthwise
Cut (4) sashes $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 72^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$, fussy cut lengthwise
1 Fat $1 / 8$ th of each of the following fabrics (piecing):
4937-N Brown Large Floral
4937-T Teal Large Floral
4938-O Orange with Gold Leaves
*4938-T Teal with Green Leaves
4939-G Green with Purple Posies
4939-P Purple with Teal Posies
4940-O Orange Stripe
4940-T Teal Stripe
4941-G Green with Teal Circles
4941-P Purple with Green Circles
4941-R Red with Gold Circles
4942-G Green Boxes
4942-T Teal Boxes
4942-Y Yellow Boxes
From each:
Cut (5) rectangles $3^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{1 / 2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$

1 Fat $1 /$ sth of each of the following fabrics (piecing):
3135-DY Dark Yellow Tic Tac
3135-LT Light Teal Tic Tac
3135-O2 Orange Tic Tac
3135-ON Red Orange Tic Tac
3135-P2 Purple Tic Tac
3135-R1 Red Tic Tac
3135-T1 Dark Teal Tic Tac
3135-V Dark Olive Tic Tac
3135-V2 Light Olive Tic Tac
4942-P Purple Boxes
4942-R Red Boxes
From each:
Cut (4) rectangles $3^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 88^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$
4942-O Fat $1 / 8$ yard Orange Boxes (piecing)
Cut (6) rectangles $3^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 88^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$
*Additional fabric required for backing.
*4938-T 51/4 yards Teal with Gold Leaves (backing)
Cut and piece to fit quilt top with 4 " overlap on all sides.

## Making \& Assembling the Quilt

1. Follow the cutting directions above for the number of $3^{1 / 2 "} \times 8^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to cut of each print. Be sure to cut the rectangles in the direction needed to cut 4,5 , or 6 from each print. You need a total of 120 rectangles. Fussy cut the border and sash strips carefully, leaving $1 / 4$ " seam allowances on long edges of each strip. The 4 borders are cut from the floral print of the stripe and the 4 sashes are cut from the circle print of the stripe. Cut each sash from a slightly different place in the print so that each is different as shown on the quilt.
2. On a large flat surface or design wall, arrange the rectangles into 5 rows, with 24 patches in each row. Follow the fabric placement diagram at right or position prints as you wish. Just be sure that the same print does not appear next to itself, and arrange the patches so that the lighter rectangles are scattered across the surface. Place the tone-on-tone Tic Tac prints between the busy prints. Before joining, look at the placement from a distance or through the wrong end of binoculars. If any print seems out of place, switch it. Join the rectangles to make the 5 rows. Press the seam allowances in one direction.
3. Refer to the Quilt Diagram on the next page. Pin a sash between the first and second pieced rows, checking that the patches line up horizontally between the rows. Sew the rows to the sash. Repeat to sew sashes between all the rows.
4. Sew the long dark brown borders to the sides, and sew the short brown borders to the top and bottom. Sew the long floral borders to the sides, noting the orientation of the flower print. Sew a dark brown $51 / 2$ " square to each end of remaining floral borders, and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt, noting the orientation of the flower print.

## Finishing the Quilt

5. Layer quilt with batting and backing. Quilt in the ditch around borders and block patches, or quilt an allover meandering motif. Bind to finish the quilt.
