# Good Seasons Winter Quilt 

## Introducing Andover Fabrics new collection: Good Seasons Winter by Carol Eldridge Quilt designed by Jean Ann Wright

Quilt finishes 44" x 52"
8 Star Blocks: 6" x 6"

Can't you just hear the children's delightful calls as they frolic in the snow in this winter wonderland? Scenes of ice skating and sledding enhance the images of this idyllic village. The novelty prints form much of the quilt, and you need to make only eight simple pieced blocks to finish the scene.

## Cutting Directions

Note: Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus $1 / 4$ " seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide).

Fabric A Fussy-cut $1 / 4$ " away from the edge of the large printed center square on each side Fussy-cut $1 / 4$ " away from the stripe border around each of the (4) small squares.

Fabric B Cut (2) borders 93/4" x $26^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric Cut (2) borders 2 $1^{\prime \prime} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Cut (2) borders $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 32^{1 / 2 \prime}$
Cut (5) $2^{1} / 22^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for binding
*Fabric D Cut (2) borders $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 241 / 2 "$
Cut (2) borders $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ " $\times 22^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Fabric Requirements

| Fabric G | blocks | $3 / 8$ yard | $1867-\mathrm{Y} 19$ |
| Fabric H | blocks | $1 / 8$ yard | $5651-\mathrm{L}$ |
| Fabric D | backing | 3 yards | $5263-\mathrm{M} 1$ |

## Making Star Blocks

1. The Star Point Units are made with a flip-and-stitch piecing method. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each Fabric G 2" square. Place a marked square on a Fabric F rectangle, right sides together, aligning raw edges at one end. Stitch on the drawn line (Diagram 1). Trim away the excess fabric from the corner. Press open. Sew and trim a second Fabric G square on the opposite end (Diagram 2). Make 32 Star Point Units in this manner.
2. To make a Star Block, sew a Star Point Unit between 2 Fabric F 2" squares. Repeat. Sew a Star Point Unit to opposite sides of a Fabric H $3^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Sew these 3 rows together to make the block. Make a total of 8 .

Fabric E Cut (2) borders $2 \frac{1}{2} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 36^{1} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$
Cut (2) borders $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 28^{1} 2^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric F Cut (32) rectangles $2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{11 / 2 "}$
Cut (32) squares $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$
Cut (3) $2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ wof strips, recut into (2)
$2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{1 / 2 "}$ pieces and (2) 2 " x $22^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces
Cut (4) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x wof srips, from each strip cut into (2) $11 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ and (2) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 10^{"}$ pieces

Fabric G Cut (64) squares 2" $\times 2$ "
Fabric $\mathbf{H}$ Cut (8) squares $3^{11 / 2 "} \times 3^{11 / 2 "}$
*Additional fabric required for backing.
Backing Cut (2) panels 30 " $\times 52^{\prime \prime}$, pieced to fit quilt top with 4 " overlap

## Assembling the Quilt

3. Refer to the Quilt Diagram. Sew the Fabric F 2 " $\times 201 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders to the top/bottom and the Fabric F 2" x $22^{1 / 2 "}$ thesides of the Fabric A printed panel. Center the panel and trim the bordered center square to $22^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime} 1 / 2$ ". Sew the fabric D $1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders to the sides and the Fabric D $11 / 2 " \times 24^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders to the top/bottom of the quilt center.
4. Join 4 pieced blocks in a vertical row as shown. Sew to the side of the quilt center. Repeat on the other side.
5. Add Fabric E borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center; sew borders to the sides. Sew Fabric C borders to the quilt in the same order.
6. Sew a fabric F $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border to opposite sides of each of the small fussy cut fabric A panels. Sew a fabric F $11 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ to top/bottom of the same squares. Center printed panel and trim each bordered square to $93 / 4$ " square. Sew these squares to each end of a Fabric B border. Sew borders to top/bottom of the quilt.

## Finishing the Quilt

7. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt the layers together. Bind to finish the quilt.
