## Introducing Andover Fabrics new collection: HEART AND SOUL by Andover Fabrics Projects designed by Janet Houts

Wall Hanging finishes $40^{\prime \prime} \times 57{ }^{\prime \prime}$
Table Topper: 40' x 40''
Placemat: 12 ' x 16"
Hearts aplenty will take the day when you display any or all of these projects in your dining area. The Table Topper and Quilt are also perfect sizes for baby blankets. This is a great project to practice stitching curves to make the hearts.

## Cutting Directions for the Wall Hanging

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances. A fat $1 / 8$ is a $9^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}-22^{\prime \prime}$ cut of fabric. A fat $1 / 4$ is an $18^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}-22^{\prime \prime}$ cut. Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide).

## Fabric A

Cut (2) borders $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 \frac{1}{2 \prime} 2^{\prime \prime}$
Cut (2) borders $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 341 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut lengthwise

## Fabric B

Cut (10) squares $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ for Frame Units
Cut (20) squares $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ for Nine Patch Blocks

## Fabric C

Cut (16) squares $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ for Nine Patch Blocks
Cut squares $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ for Heart Blocks as you desire

## Fabric D

Cut (5) squares $12^{7 / 8^{\prime \prime}}$, cut in half once diagonally to
make 10 half-square triangles for Frame Units
Cut (28) T1 patches for Heart Blocks
Cut (7) squares $31 / 2$ " for Heart Blocks
Cut (7) strips $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{1 / 2 \prime}{ }^{\prime \prime}$
Cut (7) strips $2^{1 / 21} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Cut (7) strips $1 \frac{1}{2} 1^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Cut (7) strips $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
$\mathbf{1 7}^{7}$ Brights From each: (Read Step 1 before cutting.)
Cut (3-4) squares $31 / 2$ " for Heart Blocks as you desire (a total of 63 squares)
Cut (1-2) T2 patches for Heart Blocks
(a total of 28 T 2 )

## Binding

Cut (5) strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF for binding

For the Quilt

*Yardage of Fabric A and the 17 Brights is sufficient to make all 3 projects. See additional yardage needed for Table Topper and Placemat with the individual projects.

## Making the Wall Hanging

1. Choose 13 different fabrics for each heart, plus Fabric D for the background patches. Cut some patches from Fabric C if you wish.
2. Make acrylic or cardboard templates of the T1 and T2 patterns. Poke a hole through the templates at the dots. On the back side of a bright fabric, draw around the T2 template and cut fabric out. Mark the dots on the back of the patch. Repeat to cut 4 T2 patches for each heart. Cut 4 T1 patches from Fabric D for each heart, and mark the dots.
3. With right sides together and the T 1 patch on top, align the marked dots and pin along the sewing line of the curved edges. Stitch the 2 patches together from raw edge to raw edge. Press the seam allowance toward the T2. The square should measure $3^{1 / 2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$. If it does not, adjust your sewing and pressing techniques. Make 4 of these curved units for each heart.

## Backing

Cut (2) lengths $34^{\prime \prime} \times 50^{\prime \prime}$, pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

## Heart and Soul Projects

4. Refer to the Heart Block diagram. Join 9 bright $2^{112} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares to make the heart body. Position this pieced square, 4 curved units from Step 3, and the other Fabric D patches as shown. Pay attention to the orientation of the T1/T2 units. Join the parts to make the Heart Block. Make 7 blocks.


Heart Block - Make $\mathbf{7}$ for Wall Hanging Make 4 for Table Topper Make 1 for Placemat
5. Join 5 Fabric B and 4 Fabric C $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares to make a Border Nine Patch. Make 4 all alike.

6. Cut each Fabric D large square in half diagonally (Diagram 1). Mark a diagonal line on the back side of each Fabric B $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Position this marked square on the corner of the Fabric D triangle. Stitch along the marked line (Diagram 2). Trim the extra fabric from the corner, and press the red triangle out to make a Frame Unit. Make 10.

7. Referring to the Quilt Assembly, position and join the Heart Blocks and Frame Units in diagonal rows. Stand back to be certain the Heart Blocks are oriented correctly. Join the parts into rows, and then join the rows. Sew 2 Frame Units together to make each corner, and sew to the corners.
8. Sew long Fabric A borders to the sides. Join Border Nine Patch blocks to the ends of short Fabric A borders and sew to the top and bottom.

## Finishing the Wall Hanging

9. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders and patches. Quilt the background patches as you wish. Bind to finish the quilt.


## Cutting Directions for the Table Topper

## Fabric A

Cut (4) borders $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut crosswise (Hint: If you are making the Wall Hanging also, cut the Table Topper borders lengthwise from the leftover Fabric A.)

## Fabric B

Cut (8) squares $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ for Frame Units
Cut (20) squares $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ for Nine Patch Blocks

## Fabric C

Cut (16) squares $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ for Nine Patch Blocks Cut squares $31 / 2$ " for Heart Blocks as you desire

## Fabric D

 make 8 half-square triangles for Frame Units
Cut (16) T1 patches for Heart Blocks
Cut (4) squares $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ for Heart Blocks

Cut (4) strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Cut (4) strips $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{11 / 2 "}$
Cut (4) strips $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
17 Brights From each:
(Read Step 1 before cutting.)
Cut (2-3) squares $31 / 2 \prime$ for Heart Blocks as you desire (a total of 36 squares)
Cut (1) T2 patch for Heart Blocks (a total of 16 T2)

## Binding

Cut (5) strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF for binding

## Backing

Cut (2) lengths $25^{\prime \prime} \times 50^{\prime \prime}$, pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

## Making the Table Topper

1. Read directions for the Wall Hanging. Make 4 Heart Blocks, 4 Frame Units, and 4 Nine Patch blocks.
2. Referring to the Table Topper Assembly, join 4 Heart Blocks to make the center. Sew 2 Frame Units to each side as shown.
3. Sew borders to the sides. Join a Nine Patch to each end of remaining borders and sew to the top and bottom.


Table Topper Assembly
4. Quilt and bind.

## Cutting Directions for ONE Placemat

## Fabric A

Cut (2) borders $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Fabric B

Cut (4) squares $2^{1 / 2 \prime}{ }^{\prime \prime}$

## Fabric D

Cut (4) T1 patches for Heart Block
Cut (1) square $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ for Heart Block
Cut (1) strip $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}}$
Cut (1) strip $2^{1 / 2 \prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Cut (1) strip $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{1} 2^{\prime \prime}$
Cut (1) strip $112^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## 13 Brights

Cut (9) squares $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ for Heart Block (your choice) Cut (4) T2 patch for Heart Block (your choice)

## Binding

Cut ( $11 / 2$ ) strips $21 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF for binding

## Backing

Cut (1) length $17^{\prime \prime} \times 21^{\prime \prime}$

## Making ONE Placemat

1. Read directions for the Wall Hanging. Make 1 Heart Block.
2. Mark a diagonal line on the back side of each Fabric B $2^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ square. Position a marked square on a corner of the Heart block and stitch along the marked line (Diagram 3). Trim the extra fabric from the corner, and press the red triangle out. Repeat on each corner.
3. Sew the Fabric A strips to the sides.
4. Quilt and bind to finish.

## For FOUR Placemats

*Fabric A border fat $1 / 4$ 1237-L
Fabric B blocks fat $1 / 8 \quad 1237$-R
Fabric D backgrd. $1 / 2$ yard $1244-L$
*13 Brights blocks fat $1 / 8$ each Choose 13 from the list of 17 Brights in Wall Hanging Binding $\quad 1 / 2$ yard $1244-R$ Backing 1 yard 1241-L
*Yardage for Fabric A and 17 Brights needed for the Wall Hanging is sufficient to also make the Table Topper and 4 Placemats
