Hearts aplenty will take the day when you display any or all of these projects in your dining area. The Table Topper and Quilt are also perfect sizes for baby blankets. This is a great project to practice stitching curves to make the hearts.

## **Cutting Directions for the Wall Hanging**

**Note:** Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances. A fat  $\frac{1}{4}$  is a 9" x 20"-22" cut of fabric. A fat  $\frac{1}{4}$  is an 18" x 20"-22" cut. Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately  $\frac{4}{4}$ 2" wide).

#### Fabric A

Cut (2) borders 3½" x 51½"

Cut (2) borders 3½" x 34½", cut lengthwise

#### Fabric B

Cut (10) squares 4½" for Frame Units Cut (20) squares 1½" for Nine Patch Blocks

#### Fabric C

Cut (16) squares 1½" for Nine Patch Blocks Cut squares 3½" for Heart Blocks as you desire

#### Fabric D

Cut (5) squares 12%", cut in half once diagonally to make 10 half-square triangles for Frame Units

Cut (28) T1 patches for Heart Blocks

Cut (7) squares 3½" for Heart Blocks

Cut (7) strips 2½" x 12½"

Cut (7) strips 2½" x 9½"

Cut (7) strips 1½" x 12½"

Cut (7) strips 1½" x 9½"

**17 Brights** From each: (Read Step 1 before cutting.)

Cut (3-4) squares 3½" for Heart Blocks as you desire (a total of 63 squares)

Cut (1-2) T2 patches for Heart Blocks (a total of 28 T2)

#### Binding

Cut (5) strips 2½" x WOF for binding

#### Backing

Cut (2) lengths 34" x 50", pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides



## Making the Wall Hanging


- **1.** Choose 13 different fabrics for each heart, plus Fabric D for the background patches. Cut some patches from Fabric C if you wish.
- 2. Make acrylic or cardboard templates of the T1 and T2 patterns. Poke a hole through the templates at the dots. On the back side of a bright fabric, draw around the T2 template and cut fabric out. Mark the dots on the back of the patch. Repeat to cut 4 T2 patches for each heart. Cut 4 T1 patches from Fabric D for each heart, and mark the dots.
- 3. With right sides together and the T1 patch on top, align the marked dots and pin along the sewing line of the curved edges. Stitch the 2 patches together from raw edge to raw edge. Press the seam allowance toward the T2. The square should measure 3½". If it does not, adjust your sewing and pressing techniques. Make 4 of these curved units for each heart.

4. Refer to the Heart Block diagram. Join 9 bright 2½" squares to make the heart body. Position this pieced square, 4 curved units from Step 3, and the other Fabric D patches as shown. Pay attention to the orientation of the T1/T2 units. Join the parts to make the Heart Block. Make 7 blocks.





Heart Block – Make 7 for Wall Hanging Make 4 for Table Topper Make 1 for Placemat

5. Join 5 Fabric B and 4 Fabric C 1½" squares to make a Border Nine Patch. Make 4 all alike.




Border Nine Patch Make 4 for Wall Hanging Make 4 for Table Topper





6. Cut each Fabric D large square in half diagonally (Diagram 1). Mark a diagonal line on the back side of each Fabric B 4½" square. Position this marked square on the corner of the Fabric D triangle. Stitch along the marked line (Diagram 2). Trim the extra fabric from the corner, and press the red triangle out to make a Frame Unit. Make 10.

- 7. Referring to the Quilt Assembly, position and join the Heart Blocks and Frame Units in diagonal rows. Stand back to be certain the Heart Blocks are oriented correctly. Join the parts into rows, and then join the rows. Sew 2 Frame Units together to make each corner, and sew to the corners.
- **8.** Sew long Fabric A borders to the sides. Join Border Nine Patch blocks to the ends of short Fabric A borders and sew to the top and bottom.

# Finishing the Wall Hanging

**9.** Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders and patches. Quilt the background patches as you wish. Bind to finish the quilt.

## **Cutting Directions for the Table Topper**

#### Fabric A

Cut (4) borders 3½" x 40½", cut crosswise (Hint: If you are making the Wall Hanging also, cut the Table Topper borders lengthwise from the leftover Fabric A.)

#### Fabric B

Cut (8) squares 4½" for Frame Units Cut (20) squares 1½" for Nine Patch Blocks

#### Fabric C

Cut (16) squares 1½" for Nine Patch Blocks Cut squares 3½" for Heart Blocks as you desire

#### Fabric D

Cut (4) squares 12%", cut in half once diagonally to make 8 half-square triangles for Frame Units

Cut (16) T1 patches for Heart Blocks

Cut (4) squares 3½" for Heart Blocks

Cut (4) strips 2½" x 12½"

Cut (4) strips 2½" x 9½"

Cut (4) strips 1½" x 12½"

Cut (4) strips 11/2" x 91/2"

#### 17 Brights From each:

(Read Step 1 before cutting.)

Cut (2-3) squares 3½" for Heart Blocks as you desire (a total of 36 squares)

Cut (1) T2 patch for Heart Blocks (a total of 16 T2)

#### **Binding**

Cut (5) strips 21/2" x WOF for binding

#### **Backing**

Cut (2) lengths  $25" \times 50"$ , pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

## Making the Table Topper

- 1. Read directions for the Wall Hanging. Make 4 Heart Blocks, 4 Frame Units, and 4 Nine Patch blocks.
- 2. Referring to the Table Topper Assembly, join 4 Heart Blocks to make the center. Sew 2 Frame Units to each side as shown.
- 3. Sew borders to the sides. Join a Nine Patch to each end of remaining borders and sew to the top and bottom.
- 4. Quilt and bind.

## **Cutting Directions for ONE Placemat**

#### Fabric A

Cut (2) borders 21/2" x 121/2"

#### Fabric B

Cut (4) squares 21/2"

#### Fabric D

Cut (4) T1 patches for Heart Block

Cut (1) square 3½" for Heart Block

Cut (1) strip 2½" x 12½"

Cut (1) strip 2½" x 9½"

Cut (1) strip 1½" x 12½"

Cut (1) strip 1½" x 9½"

#### 13 Brights

Cut (9) squares 3½" for Heart Block (your choice)

Cut (4) T2 patch for Heart Block (your choice)

#### **Binding**

Cut (1½) strips 2½" x WOF for binding

#### **Backing**

Cut (1) length 17" x 21"

## Making ONE Placemat

- 1. Read directions for the Wall Hanging. Make 1 Heart Block.
- 2. Mark a diagonal line on the back side of each Fabric B 21/2" square. Position a marked square on a corner of the Heart block and stitch along the marked line (Diagram 3). Trim the extra fabric from the corner, and press the red triangle out. Repeat on each corner.
- **3.** Sew the Fabric A strips to the sides.
- **4.** Quilt and bind to finish.

*13 Brights	blocks	fat 1/8 each	

Choose 13 from the list of 17 Brights in Wall Hanging

**Binding** ½ yard 1244-R **Backing** 1 yard 1241-L

\*Yardage for Fabric A and 17 Brights needed for the Wall Hanging is sufficient to also make the Table Topper and 4 Placemats



