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## Fabric Requirements

| 1747/B | 1747/S | Cow Parsley | $35 \mathrm{~cm} / 13^{\prime \prime}$ | -One 9" WOF strip cut into two 9" squares and four 4" x 9" rectangles; and <br> -One 4" WOF strip cut into eight 4" squares |
| 1747/G | 1747/G | Cow Parsley Green | One FQ | -Two 9" squares; and -Four 4" x 9" rectangles |
| 1748/B | 1748/G | Songbird | $35 \mathrm{~cm} / 13^{\prime \prime}$ | -One 9" WOF strip cut into two 9" squares and four 4" x $9^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles ( $1 \mathrm{P}+3 \mathrm{~L}$ ); and -One 4" WOF strip cut into five 4" squares |
| 1749/B4 | 1749/S4 | Paler Dash | $35 \mathrm{~cm} / 12$ " | Three 4" WOF strips cut into six 4" x 9" rectangles and nine 4 " squares |
| 1749/B8 | 1749/S8 | Darker Dash | $35 \mathrm{~cm} / 12$ " | Three 4" WOF strips cut into four 4" x 9" rectangles and thirteen 4 " squares |
| 1749/G3 | 1749/G3 | Green Dash | One FQ | Seventeen 4" squares |
| 1749/B8 | 1749/S8 | Binding | $1 / 2 \mathrm{~m} / 1 / 2 \mathrm{yd}$ | Seven $21 / 1 / 2$ WOF strips |
| 1744/B | 1744/S | Backing | $43 / 4 \mathrm{~m} / 5 \mathrm{yds}$ | Two equal lengths |

Notes:

- Read the pattern in full before starting.
- $\quad 1 / 4$ " seams are used throughout except where stated otherwise.
- Press after each seam, pressing seams open or to one side as preferred.
- WOF = width of fabric - a strip of fabric cut from selvedge to selvedge.


## Cutting

Cut the fabrics as shown in the fabric requirements table. "L" indicates a landscape rectangle and " $P$ " indicates a portrait rectangle. Only applies where directional fabrics are being cut into rectangles.

## Making the quilt top

1. The quilt top is made of forty-eight blocks (twelve of each of four designs) which will measure 9 " finished, $81 / 2$ " unfinished.
2. To make each of the twelve blocks see the diagrams below and make each as follows (NB: take care that any directional prints are orientated as shown in the main quilt image):

- Block 1 - Sash together two 4" x 9" rectangles using one 2" x 9" linen texture strip;
- Block 2 - Sash together two pairs of 4" squares using two 2 " x 4" linen texture strips. Sash those two pieces together using one 2" x 9" linen texture strip;
- Block 3 - Sash together two 4" squares using one 2" x 4" linen texture strip. Sash that piece together with one 4" x 9" rectangle using one 2" x 9" linen texture strip;
- Block 4 - The final smaller block is one 9 " square.


3. Sash the blocks into eight rows of six blocks using five 2 " $\times 9$ " strips of linen texture in each row.
4. Sash the eight rows together using the 2 " $\times 59$ " strips - one between each row, one on the top and one on the bottom. See quilt layout diagram overleaf.
5. Sash the sides of the quilt top using the two 2 " $\times 82$ " strips. See quilt layout diagram overleaf.

## Finishing the quilt

1. Sew the two pieces of backing fabric together along the long sides using a $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ seam. Press seam open.
2. Make a quilt sandwich basting together the backing, batting and quilt top.
3. Quilt as desired then trim square. We quilted a diagonal cross-hatch of lines approximately $13 / 4$ " apart using a cream 50 wt Aurifil thread.
4. Bind the quilt taking care to mitre corners.
