


Introducing Andover Fabrics new collection: **IQSC PROVENCALE** by Kathy Hall Quilt designed by Jean Ann Wright

Quilt finishes 66" x 82" 28 Blocks: 8" x 8"

The look of a French country home is reflected in these lovely floral prints. A mix of delicate floral and geometric prints joins the large-scale floral print to make a harmonious whole. The fussy-cut flowers add interest in the simple block centers.

Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include 1/4" seam allowances. Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus 1/4" seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A

Cut (1) panel $36\frac{1}{2}$ " x $52\frac{1}{2}$ " Fussy-cut (28) squares $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (Read Step 1)

Fabric B

Cut (2) borders $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $72\frac{1}{2}$ ", cut lengthwise Cut (2) borders $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $66\frac{1}{2}$ ", cut lengthwise

Fabric C

Cut (56) squares 4%" x 4%", cut in half diagonally to make 112 half-square triangles

Fabric D

Cut (28) squares $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x $5\frac{1}{4}$ ", cut in half diagonally twice to make 112 quarter-square triangles

Fabric E


Cut (2) borders $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $52\frac{1}{2}$ ", cut crosswise and pieced Cut (2) borders $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ ", cut crosswise and pieced Cut (8) strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for binding

Backing

Cut (2) panels $37" \times 90"$, pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

Making the Quilt

1. Cut the large Fabric A panel first. From the leftover fabric, fussy-cut the 28 squares so that a flower is centered in each. Cut them so half of the flowers are facing one direction and the remaining half are cut with the flower in mirror image. Refer to the Block Diagram. Matching centers, join 4 Fabric D triangles to the sides of a Fabric A square. Sew Fabric C triangles to the sides to make a block. Make 28 blocks.




Block - Make 28

- 2. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, sew long Fabric E borders to the sides of the center panel. Sew shorter borders to the top and bottom.
- **3.** Join 7 blocks to make a pieced border. Make 4 borders, noting orientation of printed flowers in block centers. Sew borders to the sides, and then sew borders to the top and bottom.
- **4.** Sew long Fabric B borders to the sides, and then sew shorter borders to the top and bottom.

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Finishing the Quilt

5. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders and block patches. Quilt around the printed motifs in the block centers, the Fabric A panel, and the outer border. Bind to finish the quilt.



Quilt Diagram


