Cutting Directions

Note: All measurements are cut sizes and include ¹/₄" seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).


- Fabric A Cut (2) squares $10^{1/2''} \times 10^{1/2''}$
- Fabric B Cut (3) squares $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ "
- Fabric C Cut (4) squares $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ "
- Fabric D Cut (2) squares $10^{1/2}$ " x $10^{1/2}$ "
- **Fabric E** Cut (2) squares $10^{1/2''} \times 10^{1/2''}$ Cut (2) rectangles $3^{1/2''} \times 10^{1/2''}$
- $\begin{array}{ll} \textbf{Fabric F} & \operatorname{Cut}\left(8\right) \operatorname{strips} 2^{\frac{1}{2}''} x \operatorname{WOF} \operatorname{for} \operatorname{binding} \\ & \operatorname{Cut}\left(2\right) \operatorname{squares} 10^{\frac{1}{2}''} x 10^{\frac{1}{2}''} \\ & \operatorname{Cut}\left(14\right) \operatorname{rectangles} 3^{\frac{1}{2}''} x 10^{\frac{1}{2}''} \end{array}$
- Fabric G Cut (22) rectangles $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ "
- Fabric H Cut (7) rectangles $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ "
- Fabric I Cut (4) sashes $5\frac{1}{2}$ x $73\frac{1}{2}$ " Cut (40) rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ x $10\frac{1}{2}$ "
- **Backing** Cut (2) panels 40" x 81", pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

Making the Quilt

- 1. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, arrange the squares and rectangles in 5 columns in the order shown. Join patches to make 5 columns. Press seam allowances in one direction.
- 2. Join the 5 columns with 4 Fabric I long sashes. Press seam allowances toward the sashes. Trim the top and bottom of the quilt as needed to straighten the edges.

Finishing the Quilt

3. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around sashes and patches. Quilt around the printed motifs as desired. Bind to finish the quilt.
