## Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42 " wide).

Fabric N $\quad \operatorname{Cut}(7)$ Template 2 triangles.
Backing Cut (2) 64" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 64 " $\times 72$ " backing.

## Making the Quilt

## 1. Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) Fabric F-Template 3 triangle, (15) assorted Template 2 triangles and (1) Fabric F-Template 1 triangle together, in that order, to make (1) column.
2. Repeat Step 1 using the remaining triangles to make (7) columns total.

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)
3. Sew the (7) columns together to make the quilt top.

## Finishing the Quilt

4. Layer and quilt as desired.
5. Sew the (6) $21 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF Fabric K strips together, end to end with a 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
6. Bind as desired.
