## Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42 " wide).

Fabric A See instructions to cut (7) flowers.
Fabric B See instructions to cut (11) flowers.
Fabric C See instructions to cut (7) flowers.
Fabric D See instructions to cut (10) flowers.
Fabric E See instructions to cut (4) flowers.
Fabric F See instructions to cut (7) flowers.
Fabric G See instructions to cut (25) frames.
Fabric H See instructions to cut (21) frames.
Fabric I Cut (8) $51 / 2$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, with diagonal seams, and cut
(2) $5^{1 / 2 \prime} \times 81$ " strips and
(2) $5^{1 / 2 "} \times 69^{\prime \prime}$ strips.

Fabric J Cut (4) $131 / 2 " \times 641 / 2$ " LOF strips.
Fabric K Cut (4) 2 " $\times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 2 " $\times 641 / 2 "$ strips.

Cut (3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 2 " $\times 55^{1 / 2 "}$ strips.

Cut (8) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for binding.

## Backing

## Making the Quilt

1. Block Assembly

Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about $1 / 8$ " outside the drawn lines.
2. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
3. Refer to the quilt photo to arrange and press the (7) back plates, (7) flowers and (7) frames onto (1) $131 / 2$ " $\times 641 / 2$ " Fabric J strip.
4. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) flower column (Diagram 1). Repeat to make (4) flower columns total.

## Quilt Top:

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)
5. Sew the (4) flower columns together to make the quilt top (Diagram 2).

6. Repeat Steps 1-4 and press the remaining (18) flowers, back plates and frames onto the quilt top centered on the seams in between the columns (Diagram 3).

7. Sew (1) 2" x $641 / 2 "$ Fabric K strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) 2" x $551 / 2 "$ Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
8. Center (1) $51 / 2 " \times 81 "$ Fabric I strip on one side of the quilt top and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $1 / 4$ " from the top edge of the quilt top and stop a $1 / 4$ " from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.
9. Repeat Step 8 to sew (1) $51 / 2 " x 69 "$ Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top, making sure to stop and start $1 / 4$ " away from each end of the quilt top. To miter each corner, fold the quilt top on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Diagram 4).
10. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Diagram 4), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining

## Finishing the Quilt

11. Layer and quilt as desired.
12. Sew the (8) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF Fabric $K$ strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
13. Bind as desired.
