# Joyful Stepping Stones 

Introducing Andover Fabrics new Collection: JOYFUL by Quilted Koala Quilt designed by Heidi Pridemore

Quilt finished 60' x 84"

This complex looking scrappy quilt is a snap to make with just two different blocks that are repeated and rotated throughout the quilt top. Make it out of these soft colors of tans and blues or make it from the other wonderful bright colors in the Joyful collection. A great project for beginners.

## Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42 " wide).

Fabric A Cut (2) $41 / 2 " x$ width of fabric (WOF) strips. Sub-cut into (18) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2$ " strips.

Cut (3) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut into (17) $21 / 2 " \times 51 / 2 "$ strips.

Fabric B Cut (2) $41 / 2$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut into (18) $41 / 2$ " squares.
Cut (3) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut into (17) $51 / 2$ " squares.
Cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut into (17) $2^{1 / 2 "}$ squares.
Cut (8) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric C Cut (2) 3 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut into (18) 3 " squares.

Cut (5) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut into (17) $21 / 2 "$ x $91 / 2 "$ strips.

Fabric D $\quad$ Cut (3) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (18) 5 " $\times 51 / 2 "$ strips.
Cut (5) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut into (17) $3^{1 / 2 "} \times 81 / 2 "$ strips.

Cut (3) $51 / 2$ x $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut into (18) $51 / 2$ " squares.

Cut (2) $31 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut into (17) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ strips.

Cut (3) $51 / 2$ " $x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut into
(35) $31 / 2 " \times 51 / 2 "$ strips.

Cut (1) $51 / 2$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut into (18) 2 " $\times 5^{1 / 2 "}$ " strips.

Cut (1) 3 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut into
(18) $2 " \times 3$ " strips.

Cut (2) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut into (17) $31 / 2$ " $\times 41 / 2$ " strips.

Cut (2) 4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into (18) 3 " x 4 " strips.

Cut (2) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut into (17) $31 / 2$ " $\times 4^{1 / 2 "}$ strips.

Cut (2) $71 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut into (18) $3^{1 / 2 "} x^{r} 7^{1 / 2 "}$ strips.

Cut (2) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into (18) 3 " squares.

Cut (2) $21 / 2$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut into (17) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ strips.

Cut three $21 / 2$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut into (17) $21 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.

Cut (2) 92 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 68 " $\times 92$ " to make the back.

## Making the Quilt

## 1. Block One

Follow Diagram 1 and sew (1) $31 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric A strip, (1) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric B square, (1) 3 " Fabric C square, (1) $3^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I square, (1) $3^{1 / 2 "} \times 7^{1 / 2 \prime}$ " Fabric I strip, (1) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric D strip, (1) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{1 / 2}{ }^{\prime}$ Fabric G strip, (1) 2 " $\times 3$ " Fabric G strip, (1) 3 " $\times 4$ " Fabric H strip, (1) $31 / 2 " \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F strip and (1) $51 / 2$ " Fabric E square together to make (1) Block One. Repeat to make (18) Block One squares total.

## 2. Block Two

Follow Diagram 2 and sew (1) $31 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip, (1) $31 / 2 " \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H strip, (1) $3^{1 / 2 "} \times 41 / 2$ " Fabric G strip, (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric B square, (1) $21 / 2$ " $\times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip, (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2 "$ Fabric A strip, (1) $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B square, (1) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2$ " Fabric F strip, (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip, (1) $21 / 2$ " $\times 6^{1 / 2 " ~ F a b r i c ~ I ~ s t r i p ~ a n d ~(1) ~} 2^{1 / 2 "} \times 9^{1 / 2 "}$

Fabric C strip together to make (1) Block Two. Repeat to make (17) Block Two squares total.

## 3. Quilt Top

Refer to Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.
Sew (3) Block Ones and (2) Block Twos together to make Row One. Repeat to make Rows Three, Five and Seven. Pay close attention to the orientation of the blocks as some are rotated.
4. Sew (3) Block Twos and (2) Block Ones together to make Row Two. Repeat to make Rows Four and Six. Pay close attention to the orientation of the blocks as some are rotated.
5. Sew the (7) rows together, in numerical order, to make the quilt top.

## Finishing the Quilt

6. Layer and quilt as desired.
7. Sew the (8) $2^{1 / 2 " x}$ WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
8. Bind as desired.
