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# Kim's Hand Dyes, Series 2 

Introducing Andover Fabrics new collection: Kim's Hand Dyes, Series 2 by Kim Schaefer Quilt designed by Kim Schaefer

Quilt finishes 60' x 82'
35 Blocks: 8' x 8'

Mix and match these fun, contemporary fabrics to make 35 simple blocks, and frame them with a neutral gray. Some blocks will "pop" and others will lay back to surprise the viewer. Easy enough for a beginning quilter, the quilt is perfect for a twin bed or to use as a throw.

## Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances. A fat $1 / 4$ is an $18^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}-22^{\prime \prime}$ cut. Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide).

## Fabric A

Cut (2) borders $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 74^{1} 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut lengthwise
Cut (2) borders $412^{\prime \prime} \times 601 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut lengthwise
Cut (6) long sashes $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 521 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut lengthwise
Cut (28) short sashes $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Fabric B

Cut (8) strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF for binding

## 22 Fat $1 / 4$ 's

Read Step 1 before cutting patches from fat $1 / 4$ 's
Cut (35) squares $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (total)
Cut (70) strips $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (cut in sets of 2)
Cut (70) strips $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (cut in sets of 2)

## Backing

Cut (2) panels $34^{\prime \prime} \times 90^{\prime \prime}$, pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

## Making the Quilt

1. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, for each block choose a $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square for the center and choose a second fabric for the framing strips. Cut the number of patches from each fabric as shown in the quilt, or since fabric is generous, feel free to cut more patches from your favorite fabrics. Referring to the Block Diagram, sew $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to sides of a $6{ }^{1 / 2 "}$ " square. Press seam allowances away from the square. Sew $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom. Press seam allowances away from the square to make the block. It should measure $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from edge to edge. Make 35 different blocks.


## Kim's Hand Dyes, Series 2 Quilt

2. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, join 5 blocks alternately with 4 Fabric A short sashes to make a horizontal row. Press seam allowances toward the short sashes. Make 7 rows. Join the block rows alternately with 6 long sashes.
3. Sew long borders to the sides of the quilt. Sew short borders to the top and bottom.

## Finishing the Quilt

4. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders and block patches. Quilt a motif of your choice in the center squares. Or quilt an overall design across the quilt. Bind to finish the quilt.
