






Quilt finishes 52" x 64"

Laura Ingalls Wilder would feel right at home snuggling under this charming throw-size quilt. The printed panel of Laura running through a field evokes memories of days gone by. The charm squares are arranged in a pleasing manner to give some movement for the eye to follow.

Fabric Requirements

Fabric A	setting	1 panel (3/3 yard)	8225-N
Fabric B	border, binding	⅓ yard	8250-B
5" Charms	setting	2 pack	
Backing		3½ yards	7924-L

Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances. A fat $\frac{1}{4}$ is an 18" x 22" cut. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A

Cut (1) panel 221/2" x 421/2", cut crosswise

Fabric B

Cut (6) strips 21/2" x WOF for binding

Cut (2) borders 2½" x 42½", cut crosswise

Cut (2) borders $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $26\frac{1}{2}$ ", cut crosswise

2 Charm Pks. From each 5" square:

Cut (4) squares 2½" x 2½" (267 light total, 266 dark total)

Backing


Cut (2) panels 36" x 60", pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

Making the Quilt

- 1. Fussy-cut the panel from Fabric A. Sew long Fabric B strips to the sides. Sew the short strips to the top and bottom.
- 2. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, position 2½" squares on the left side and top of the panel, alternating light and dark prints as shown. Be sure that a dark print is in the top left corner. Join the squares and sew to the top and left of the panel.
- 3. On a large flat surface or design wall, arrange squares in horizontal rows along the right side and bottom of the panel, alternating light and dark prints. Note that the prints are placed to form a diagonal design. Stand back to be sure that light and dark prints alternate. Feel free to arrange the prints in any order you wish. Once you are satisfied with the design, join the squares into rows. Sew the right side unit to the right side. Sew the bottom unit to the bottom.

Finishing the Quilt

4. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders and patches. Quilt around the printed motifs in the center panel. Bind to finish the quilt.



Quilt Diagram


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Blend with Prairie Icons from Andover
