

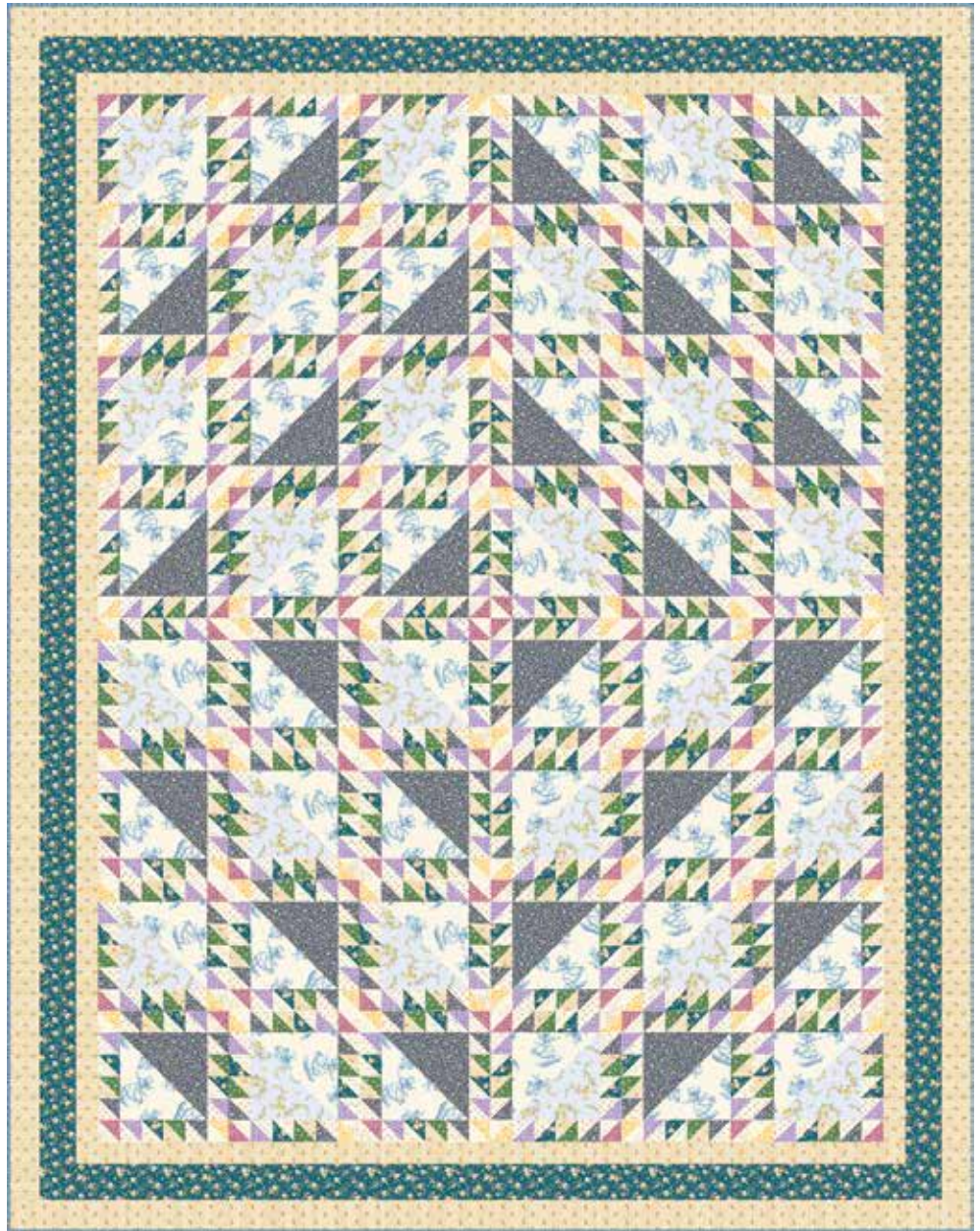

Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A Cut (4) $6\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) $6\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

Fabric B Cut (2) $6\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) $6\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

Fabric C Cut (2) $6\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) $6\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.
Cut (6) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (96) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " squares.

Fabric D Cut (6) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (96) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " squares.

Fabric E Cut (6) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (96) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " squares.
Cut (4) 3" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 3" x $75\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
Cut (4) 3" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 3" x $62\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric F Cut (6) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (96) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " squares.

Fabric G Cut (3) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (48) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " squares.

Fabric H Cut (6) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (96) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " squares.

Fabric I Cut (6) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (96) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " squares.

Fabric J Cut (6) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (96) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " squares.
Cut (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 2" x $72\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
Cut (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 2" x $57\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
Cut (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $80\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
Cut (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $66\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric K Cut (6) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (96) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " squares.

Fabric L Cut (6) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (96) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " squares.

Fabric M Cut (3) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (48) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " squares.

Fabric N Cut (8) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

Backing Cut (2) 92" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 74" x 92" backing.

Mary's Quilt

Making the Quilt

1. Block Assembly

Place (1) $6\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric A square on top of (1) $6\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric B square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Diagram 1). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 1). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Diagram 2) to make (2) BA units (Diagram 3). Trim the BA units to measure $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make (24) BA units total.

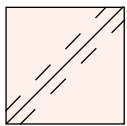

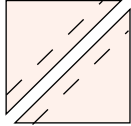

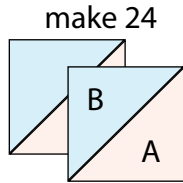

2. Repeat Step 1 using (12) $6\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric A squares and (12) $6\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric C squares to make (24) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " CA units (Diagram 4).
3. Repeat Step 1 using (48) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric H squares and (48) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric M squares to make (96) 2" MH units (Diagram 5).
4. Repeat Step 1 using (96) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric I squares and (96) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric C squares to make (192) 2" CI units (Diagram 6).

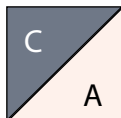

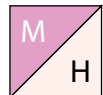

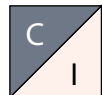

5. Repeat Step 1 using (96) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric J squares and (96) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric D squares to make (192) 2" DJ units (Diagram 7).
6. Repeat Step 1 using (96) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric K squares and (96) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric E squares to make (192) 2" EK units (Diagram 8).

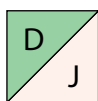

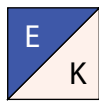

7. Repeat Step 1 using (96) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric L squares and (96) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric F squares to make (192) 2" FL units (Diagram 9).
8. Repeat Step 1 using (48) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric H squares and (48) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " Fabric G squares to make (96) 2" GH units (Diagram 10).

9. Follow Diagram 11 and sew (4) assorted units together to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to each side of (1) BA unit. Sew (6) assorted units together to make one strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the BA unit to make (1) Block One. Repeat to make (24) Block Ones total.

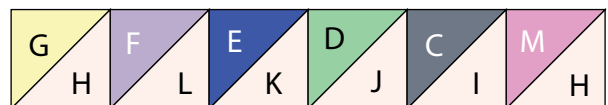
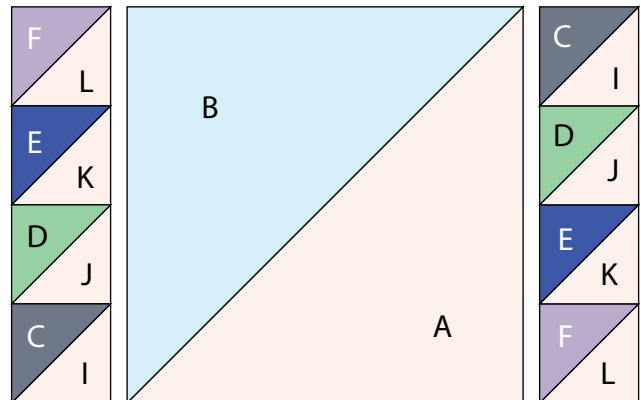
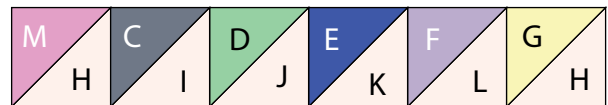

Mary's Quilt

- 10.** Follow Diagram 12 and sew (4) assorted units together to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to each side of (1) CA unit. Sew (6) assorted units together to make one strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the CA unit to make (1) Block Two. Repeat to make (24) Block Twos total.

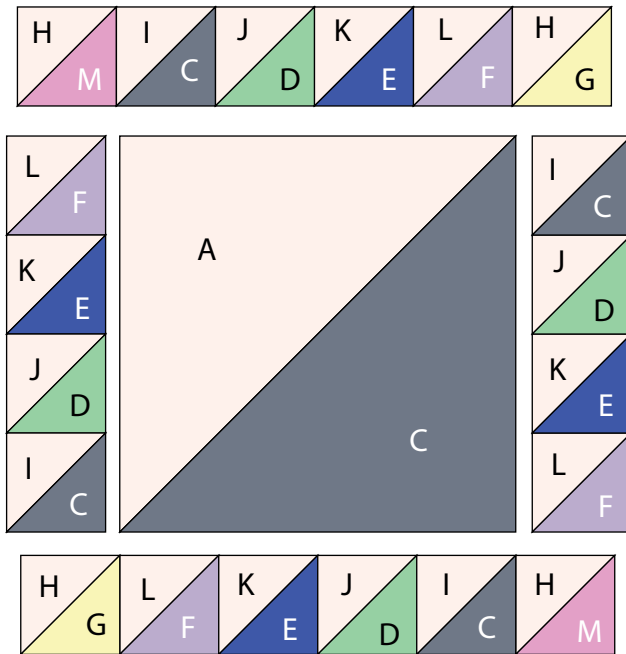

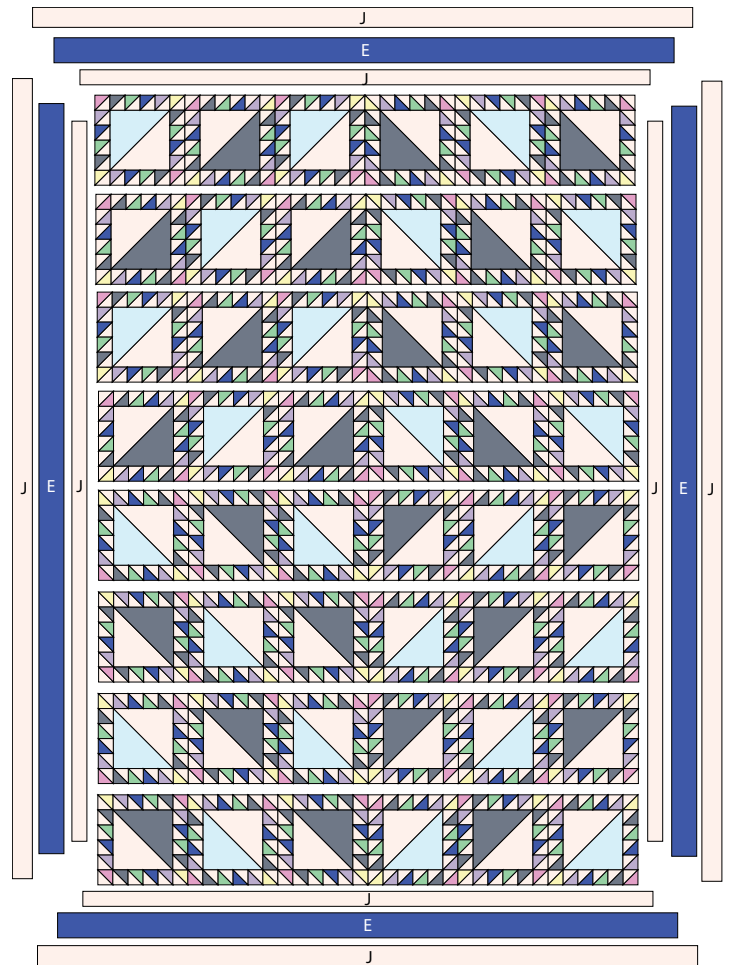
Quilt Top:

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)

- 11.** Sew (3) Block Ones and (3) Block Twos together, alternating them, to make Row One. Repeat to make Rows Three, Five and Seven.
- 12.** Sew (3) Block Twos and (3) Block Ones together, alternating them, to make Row Two. Repeat to make Rows Four, Six and Eight.
- 13.** Sew the (8) rows together, in numerical order, to make the quilt top.
- 14.** Sew (1) 2" x 72 1/2" Fabric J strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) 2" x 57 1/2" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
- 15.** Sew (1) 3" x 75 1/2" Fabric E strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) 3" x 62 1/2" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
- 16.** Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 80 1/2" Fabric J strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 66 1/2" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.

Finishing the Quilt

- 17.** Layer and quilt as desired.
- 18.** Sew the (8) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric N strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 19.** Bind as desired.



Quilt Layout

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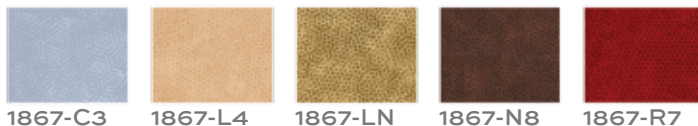
