# Too Elegant to Cut 

Featuring Andover Fabrics new Collection: Mandalay by Kathy Hall Quilt designed by Heidi Pridemore

## Quilt finished 44" x 60'

## Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42 " wide).

Fabric A Cut (1) $231 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ strip.
Fabric B Cut (1) $61 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) $61 / 2$ " squares.
Cut (4) $61 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (36) $41 / 2 " \times 61 / 2$ " strips.

Fabric C Cut (10) $2^{1 / 2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (160) $21 / 2$ " squares.
Cut (2) $31 / 2$ " $\times 401 / 2$ " WOF strips.
Cut (2) $31 / 2$ " $\times 281 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips.
Cut (5) $21 / 1 / 2$ x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, with diagonal seams, and cut
(2) $21 / 2 " \times 561 / 2 " \times(2) 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 441 / 2 "$ strips.
Cut (6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

Backing Cut (2) 52 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 52 " $\times 68$ " backing.

## Making the Quilt

1. Block Assembly

Place (1) $21 / 2$ " Fabric C square on the top left corner of (1) $61 / 2 "$ Fabric B square, right sides together (Diagram 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn seam.

3 yards 7932-MB
2. Follow Diagram 3 for the seam direction to add a $21 / 2$ " Fabric C square to each of the remaining corners of the 6 $1 / 2$ " Fabric B square to make (1) Corner Block (Diagram 4).

3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (4) Corner Blocks total.
4. Repeat Steps 1 - 2 using (36) $41 / 2 " \times 61 / 2$ " Fabric B strips and (144) $21 / 2$ " Fabric C squares to make (36) BC-blocks (Diagram 5).

## Quilt Top: <br> (Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)

5. Sew (1) $3^{1 / 2 "} \times 40^{1 / 2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of the $23^{1 / 2 "} \times 401 / 2 "$ Fabric A strip. Sew (1) $31 / 2 " \times 28^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A strip to make the Center Block. Trim the Center Block to measure $281 / 2$ " $441 / 2$.
6. Sew (11) BC-blocks together lengthwise to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the Center Block.

## Too Elegant to Cut

7. Sew (7) BC-blocks together to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) Corner Block to each end of both strips. Sew the resulting strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
8. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 561 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $21 / 2$ " $\times 441 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

## Finishing the Quilt

9. Layer and quilt as desired.
10. Sew the (6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric $C$ strips together, end to end with a 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
11. Bind as desired.
