# Many Moons Quilt 

Introducing Andover Fabrics new collection: Many Moons by Kathy Hall for the Museum of International Folk Art, Museum of New Mexico Foundation Quilt designed by Gail Kessler

## Planning

The unusual novelty print can be fussy cut into several different scenes that enhance the block centers. Softly colored floral and leaf prints add a touch of elegance, and the lone brown print adds a note of drama. The fast flying geese that surround the quilt center are a snap to make. The quilt fits a double bed nicely, and is large enough for a queen-size comforter.

Quilt finishes 82" x 100"
12 Pieced Blocks: $16^{\prime \prime} \times 16^{\prime \prime}$

## Fabric Requirements \& Cutting Directions

Note: Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus $1 / 4$ " seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide).
4338-E 13/4 yards Novelty Pictorial Print (block centers)
Cut (12) A patches, fussy-cut so novelty print is centered in each octagon
4339-E $\quad 2^{1 ⁄ 2}$ yards Pink with Cream Mottled Print (block piecing, flying geese)
Cut (24) strips 1" x 161/2" (block frames)
Cut (24) strips $1^{\prime \prime} \times 15^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ (block frames)
Cut (48) D patches (block corners)
Cut (276) squares $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1 / 2 "}$ (flying geese corners)
4340-E 3 yards Rose with Spots (outer border, binding)
Cut (2) strips $71 / 2 " \times 86^{1 / 2 "}$ (side borders, cut lengthwise)
Cut (2) strips $71 / 2 " \times 82^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ (top/bottom borders, cut lengthwise)
Cut (4) strips $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 95^{\prime \prime}$ (binding, cut lengthwise)
4341-G 15/8 yards Light Green Leaves (block piecing)
Cut (96) B patches (block background)
Cut (96) C patches (block background)
4342-G 11/s yards Green with Pink Posies (sashes)
Cut (31) sashing strips $21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 16^{1 / 2 "}$
2847-E2 1½ yards Dark Pink Many Eyes Looking (block piecing, flying geese, setting squares)
Cut (69) rectangles $2^{1 / 21} \times 4^{1 / 2 \prime}$ (flying geese)
Cut (96) B patches (block points)
Cut (20) squares $2^{1 / 2 "} \times 2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (setting squares)
2847-N2 11/4 yards Brown Many Eyes Looking (block piecing, inner border, corner squares)
Cut (8) strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF pieced to make the following: 2 borders $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 74 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ (side borders) 2 borders $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 60^{1 / 2 "}$ (top/bottom borders)
Cut (4) squares $41 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{1 / 2 "}$ (corner squares)
Cut (96) B patches (block points)

2847-Y4 1¹/s yards Gold Many Eyes Looking (block piecing, flying geese)
Cut (69) rectangles $2^{1 / 2 "} \times 4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ (flying geese)
Cut (96) B patches (block points)
*Additional fabric required for backing.
*4339-E 7½ yards Pink with Cream Mottled Print (backing)
Cut 3 panels $36^{\prime \prime} \times 90^{\prime \prime}$, pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides.

## Making \& Assembling the Quilt

1. Prepare a see-through template for the A patch, rotating the $1 / 2$ pattern to complete the octagon. Fussy cut 12 A patches, centering the novelty print. Cut a variety of motifs. Referring to the Block Diagram, join patches to make 12 blocks.

2. Refer to the Quilt Diagram throughout the assembly. Join 3 sashes alternately with 4 dark pink $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ setting squares to make a sash row. Press seam allowances toward the sashes. Make 5 sash rows.
3. Join 3 blocks alternately with 4 sashes to make a block row. Press seam allowances toward the sashes. Make 4 block rows. Join the rows, alternating types.
4. Sew long brown borders to the sides. Sew short brown borders to top and bottom.
5. Referring to Diagram 1, draw a diagonal line on wrong side of each $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pink with cream square. Place a marked square on a $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ $4^{1 / 2}$ " rectangle, right sides together, aligning raw edges. Sew on marked line; trim away and discard excess fabric. Press open. Repeat process on opposite end to make a flying geese unit. Make 69 pink flying geese units and 69 gold flying geese units.
6. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, join 39 flying geese units to make each side border, noting color placement. Sew to opposite sides. Join 30 flying geese units to make the top border. Sew a brown $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square to each end and sew border to the quilt. Repeat for the bottom border.
7. Sew long dark pink borders to the sides. Sew short borders to top and bottom.

## Finishing the Quilt

8. Layer quilt with batting and backing. Quilt in the ditch around borders and block patches. Quilt around printed motifs in the block centers. Quilt as desired in the wide outer border. Bind to finish the quilt.
