# Need It Neutrals Quilt 

## Planning

This subtle quilt fits nearly any décor. Its quiet simplicity is perfect for a lap throw. The easy construction makes this quilt the perfect place to showcase your machine quilting skills.

## Fabric Requirements and Cutting Directions

Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances. WOF refers to width of fabric (approximately 42" wide from selvedge to selvedge).

## $1 / 4$ th yard each of the following fabrics (blocks)

## From each:

Cut (5) $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares (a total of 63 are needed, 2 will be discarded)
3104-L Tan Squiggles
3104-N1 Light Brown Squiggles
*3133-L2 Tan Stars
3133-N3 Light Brown Stars
3489-L Tan Blossoms
3489-N1 Light Brown Blossoms
3939-L Tan Pebbles
3939-N Light Brown Pebbles
4061-L Tan Squares
4061-LN Light Brown Squares
4062-L Tan Olives
4062-N Light Brown Olives
4063-L Light Stripes
3135-L $\quad 21 / 2$ yards Tan Tic Tac Print (border, sashes, binding)
Cut (16) strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF to make:
2 borders $801 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ long
2 borders $661 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ long
continuous strip for binding
Cut (27) strips $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF to make:
8 long sashes $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 621 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
54 short sashes $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

* Additional fabric required for backing.
*3133-L2 51⁄8 yards Tan Stars (backing)
Cut and piece to fit quilt top with 4 " overlap on all sides.


## Making and Assembling the Quilt

1. Refer to the Quilt Diagram throughout the assembly. Arrange the 63 light print $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares randomly. Join 7 squares with 6 short sashes to make a horizontal row. Make 9 rows. Join rows alternately with 8 long sashes.
2. Sew the long borders to the sides. Sew the shorter borders to the top and bottom.

## Finishing the Quilt

3. Layer quilt with batting and backing. Machine quilt an overall meandering stitch across the quilt, or quilt a motif of your choice in each $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Bind with dimples print to finish quilt.
