

## Cutting Directions

**Note: Read assembly directions before cutting**

**patches.** Borders are cut to exact length required plus 1/4" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

**Fabric A** Fussy cut (9) 6 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles, each centered on a block.

**Fabric D** Fussy cut (4) 6 1/2" x 58" strips, each centered on fringe.

**Fabric B** Cut (9) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (17) 2 1/2" x 20" strips.

**Binding** Cut (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

**Fabric C** Cut (1) 4 1/2" x 20" strip from each Fat 1/8 for a total of (17) strips.

**Backing** Cut (2) 62" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 62" x 62" backing.

## Making the Quilt

### 1. Block Assembly

Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 20" Fabric C strip to the left side of (1) 2 1/2" x 20" Fabric B strip lengthwise to make (1) Strip Set (Diagram 1). Repeat to make (17) Strip Sets total.



2. Cut (6) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips from each Strip Set to make (102) Unit 1 strips (Diagram 2).

3. Sew together (21) Unit 1 strips lengthwise to make (1) Block One strip (Diagram 3). Repeat to make (4) Block One strips total.

4. Sew together (2) Unit 1 strips, (1) 6 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric A strip, (1) Unit 1 strip, (1) 6 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric A strip, (1) Unit 1 strip, (1) 6 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric A strip and (2) Unit 1 strips, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) Block Two strip (Diagram 4). Repeat to make (3) Block Two strips total.



5. Sew together the (4) Block One strips and (3) Block Two strips, lengthwise and alternating them from left to right, to make the 42 1/2" x 42 1/2" Center Block.



### Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)

- Center (1) 6 1/2" x 58" Fabric D strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a 1/4" from the top edge of the block and stop a 1/4" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.
- Repeat Step 6 to sew (1) 6 1/2" x 58" strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start 1/4" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides.
- Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Diagram 6), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the quilt top.




## Finishing the Quilt

9. Layer and quilt as desired.
10. Sew the (6) binding strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
11. Bind as desired.






