

## **Cutting Directions**

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus ¼" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A	Fussy cut (1) 23'	' x 42 ½" panel.
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Fabric B	Cut (2) $2$ " x $42 \frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
	Cut (2) 2" x 26" WOF strips.
	See instructions to cut (4) Crests.
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See instructions to cut (32) Luckenbooth designs.

Cut (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

### Fabric C

Cut (2) 3 ½" x 44 ½" LOF strips. Cut (2) 2 ½" x 30 ½" WOF strips from the remaining fabric.

#### Fabric D

Cut (3) 7 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 7 ½" x 48 ½" strips.

Cut (3) 7 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 7 ½" x 44 ½" strips.

#### Fabric E

Cut (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2)

2" x  $62 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Cut (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 47 ½" strips.

#### Fabric F

Cut (4)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $65\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Cut (3) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 ½" x 53 ½" strips.

### **Backing**

Cut (2) 61" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 61" x 79" backing.



## Making the Quilt

### 1. Block Assembly

Sew (1) 2" x 42 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 23" x 42 ½" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x 26" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure 24 ½" x 44 ½" to make the Center Block (Diagram 1).

- 2. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- **3.** Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.

## Luckenbooth

- **4.** Arrange and press (2) Crest emblems and (6) Luckenbooth designs onto (1) 7 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric D strip as shown in Diagram 2.
- **5.** Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) Top/Bottom Border.
- **6.** Repeat Steps 4-5 to make a second Top/Bottom Border.
- 7. Repeat Steps 4-5 using (20) Luckenbooth designs and (2) 7 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric D strips to make (2) Side Borders (Diagram 3).

#### **Quilt Top Assembly**

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)

- **8.** Sew (1) 3 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 30 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- **9.** Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) Top/Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- **10.** Sew (1) 2" x 62 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 47 ½" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- **11.** Sew (1) 3 ½" x 65 ½" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 53 ½" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

## Finishing the Quilt

- 12. Layer and quilt as desired.
- **13.** Sew the (7) Fabric B binding strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 14. Bind as desired.


