## Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42 " wide).

Fabric A Cut (2) $21 / 2$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (28) $21 / 2$ " squares.
Cut (48) Template 1 triangles.
Cut (48) Template 3 triangles.
See instructions to cut (3) ovals.
Fabric B Cut (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 2" x 8" strips.
Cut (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (4) 2 " x 11 " strips.
Cut (1) 2 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 2 " x 4" strips.
Cut (1) 2 " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 2 " x $61 / 2$ " strips.
See instructions to cut (3) oval frames.
Fabric C Cut (1) $151 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (3) $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 15^{1 / 2 "}$ strips and (4) $31 / 2$ " x $101 / 2$ " strips.
Cut (1) $91 / 2 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 1 " $\times 91 / 2 "$ strips and (4) $23 / 4$ " $\times 6$ " strips.
Cut (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) $21 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ strip and (2) $1 \frac{1 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 " \text { strips. }}{2}$.

Fabric D Fussy cut (4) $61 / 2$ " squares, each centered on a medallion.
Fussy cut (2) 8" squares, each centered on words.
Fussy cut (2) $31 / 2$ " x 4 " strips, each centered on a crest.
Fussy cut (1) 20 " square, centered on portrait for bonus pillow front.

Fabric E Cut (1) $21 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) $21 / 2$ " $\times 31 / 2$ " strips.
Cut (2) $21 / 2$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (10) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
Cut (10) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the

strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (8) $21 / 2 " \times 481 / 2 "$ strips.
Cut (2) $21 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (14) $21 / 2$ " $\times 41 / 2 "$ strips and (4) $21 / 2$ " squares.

Fabric $\mathbf{F} \quad$ Cut (24) Template 2 diamonds.
Fabric G Cut (24) Template 2 diamonds.
Fabric H Cut (48) Template 1 triangles.
Cut (48) Template 3 triangles.
Fabric I Cut (6) $21 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF strips for the binding.
Fabric J See instructions to cut (3) silhouettes.
Fabric K Cut (2) $11 / 2$ " $\times 301 / 2$ " WOF strips.
Cut (2) $31 / 2 " \times 321 / 2$ " WOF strips.
Backing
Cut (2) 68" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 68" x 68" backing.

Bonus Pillow Cut (1) 14 " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into

## Making the Quilt

1. Block Assembly

Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about $1 / 8$ " outside the drawn lines.
2. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
3. Refer to the quilt photo to arrange and press (1) Fabric J silhouette, (1) Fabric A silhouette background and (1) Fabric B frame onto (1) $101 / 2$ " $\times 151 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip.
4. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) Block One (Diagram 1).
5. Repeat Steps $3-4$ using the remaining (2) silhouettes, (2) silhouette backgrounds, (2) frames and (2) $101 / 2$ " x $151 / 2{ }^{\prime}$ Fabric C strips to make (1) Block Two and (1) Block Three.

6. Sew (1) $2 " x 8 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 8" Fabric D square (words). Sew (1) 2" x 11 " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric D square. Trim the block to measure $91 / 2$ " square to make (1) large D block (Diagram 2). Repeat to make a second large D block.

7. Sew (1) $1 " \times 91 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of (1) large D block. Sew (1) $31 / 2$ " $\times 101 / 2$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the large D block to make (1) Block Four (Diagram 3). Repeat to make a second Block Four.

8. Sew (1) $2 " x 4 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $31 / 2 " x 4 "$ Fabric D strip (crests). Sew (1) 2" x $61 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric D square. Trim the block to measure 6" square to make (1) small D block (Diagram 4). Repeat to make a second small D block.

9. Sew (1) $23 / 4$ " $\times 6$ " Fabric C strip to each side of the (2) small D blocks. Sew the (2) resulting strips to the top and to the bottom of (1) $21 / 2$ " $\times 101 / 2$ " Fabric C strip lengthwise. Sew (1) $11 / 2$ " $\times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the resulting block to make (1) Block Five (Diagram 5).

10. Sew (1) Block Four to each side of (1) Block One to make Row One.
11. Sew (1) Block Two to the left side of (1) Block Five. Sew (1) Block Three to the right side of the Block Five to make Row Two.
12. Sew the (2) rows together lengthwise. Sew (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 301 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric K strip to each side of the block. Sew (1) $31 / 2$ "x $321 / 2$ " Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the block to make the Center Block (Diagram 6).

13. Place (1) Fabric A-Template 1 triangle on top left side of (1) Fabric F-Template 2 diamond, right sides together, aligning the left sides (Diagram ${ }^{7}$ ). Sew the two pieces together along the top left side. Press the small triangle open.

14. Place (1) Fabric A-Template 1 triangle on the bottom right side of the Fabric F-Template 2 diamond, left sides together, aligning the sides (Diagram 8). Sew the two pieces together along the lower right side. Press the small triangle open.
15. Place (1) Fabric A-Template 3 triangle on top right side of (1) Fabric F-Template 2 diamond, right sides together, aligning the right sides (Diagram 9). Sew the two pieces together along the top right side. Press the small triangle open.

16. Place (1) Fabric A-Template 3 triangle on the bottom left side of the Fabric F-Template 2 diamond, right sides together, aligning the sides (Diagram 10). Sew the two pieces together along the lower left side. Press the small triangle open. Trim the block to measure $41 / 2$ ’ x $61 / 2$ " to make (1) Block Six (Diagram 11). Repeat Steps 13-16 to make (24) Block Sixes total.

17. Repeat Steps 13-16 using (24) Fabric G diamonds, (48) Fabric H Template 1 triangles and (48) Fabric H Template 3 triangles to make (24) Block Sevens (Diagram 12).

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18. Sew (6) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric A squares and (5) $21 / 2$ " $\times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric E strips together, end to end and alternating them to make (1) EA strip. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to each end of the EA strip. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 481 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the EA strip to make (1) Top/Bottom Border (Diagram 13). Repeat to make a second Top/Bottom Border.
19. Sew (8) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric A squares and (7) $21 / 2 \times \times 1 / 2$ " Fabric E strips together end to end and alternating them to make (1) EA strip. Sew (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric E square to each end of the EA strip. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 481 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the EA strip lengthwise to make (1) Side Border (Diagram 14). Repeat to make a second Side Border.

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)
20. Sew (6) Block Sixes and (6) Block Sevens together into (2) strips of (6) units each, alternating the units. Sew the (2) strips together lengthwise to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the Center Block.
21. Sew (6) Blocks Sixes and (6) Block Sevens together lengthwise, alternating them, to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block. Pay attention to the orientation of the strips.
22. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $61 / 2 "$ Fabric D square (medallion) to each end of (1) Top/Bottom Border. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

## Finishing the Quilt

23. Layer and quilt as desired.
24. Sew the (6) Fabric I binding strips together, end to end with a 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
25. Bind as desired.

## BONUS Pillow

26. To make the back envelope flaps, turn under the $201 / 2$ " edge approximately $1 / 4 "$, press and repeat, then stitch to make a finished edge on one edge of the pillow back $141 / 2 " \times 201 / 2 "$ piece. Repeat with the second $141 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 201 / 2 "$ pillow back piece.

2\%. Position and pin the each back envelope flap, right sides together with the 20 " Fabric D pillow front, overlapping the finished edges in the middle and aligning the raw edges with the pillow front. Stitch around the pillow front and back to complete the pillow.
28. Turn the pillow right side out and insert pillow form.
