## Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42 " wide).

Fabric A Fussy cut (1) $201 / 2$ " square, centered on the Characters.
Fussy cut (2) 8 " squares, each centered on a word block.
Fussy cut (4) $41 / 2$ " squares, each centered on a symbol.
Fussy cut (4) $61 / 2$ " squares, each centered on a medallion.

Fabric B $\quad$ Cut (3) $37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (26) $37 / \mathrm{s}^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (52) large triangles.
Cut (2) $41 / 4$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (13) $41 / 4$ " squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (52) small triangles.
Cut (2) $11 / 4 " \times 421 / 2$ " WOF strips.
Cut (2) $11 / 2$ " $\times 241 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips.
Cut (7) $21 / 2$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric C Cut (3) $31 / 2$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $3^{1 / 2 "} \times 44 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Cut (2) $21 / 2$ " $\times 301 / 2$ " WOF strips.
Cut (4) $21 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut
(2) $21 / 2 " \times 601 / 2 "$ strips.

Cut (3) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 461 / 2$ " strips.

Fabric D Cut (3) $37 / 8$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (26) $3^{7 / 8 /}$ squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (52) large triangles.
Cut (2) $41 / 4$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (13) $41 / 4$ " squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (52) small triangles.

Fabric E Cut (3) $41 / 4 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (26) $41 / 4$ " squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (104) triangles.

Fabric F $\quad$ Cut (2) $41 / 2 " \times 641 / 2 "$ LOF strips.
Cut (2) $41 / 2$ " $\times 541 / 2$ " WOF strips from the remaining fabric, piece as needed.

Fabric G $\quad \operatorname{Cut}$ (2) 3 " $\times 24^{1 / 2 "}$ WOF strips.
Cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 201 / 2 "$ LOF strips. From the remaining fabric, cut (2) $21 / 4$ " x 23 " WOF strips, (8) $21 / 4 " x 8$ " strips and (8) $41 / 2 " \times 21 / 4 "$ strips.

## Backing Cut (2) 62" x WOF strips. Sew the strips

 together and trim to make (1) 62 " $\times 80$ " backing.
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## Making the Quilt

1. Block Assembly

Sew (1) $21 / 2$ " $\times 20^{1 / 2 "}$
Fabric G strip to each side of the $201 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric A square. Sew (1) $3 " \times 241 / 2$ " Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square. Trim the block to measure 23 " x 24 " to make the Unit 1 (Diagram 1).

2. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 21 / 4 "$ Fabric G strip to each side of (1) $41 / 2$ " Fabric A square. Sew (1) $21 / 4 " \times 8 "$ Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 2 (Diagram 2). Repeat to make (4) Unit 2's total.

3. Sew (1) Unit 2 to each side of (1) 8 " Fabric A square. Sew (1) $21 / 4 "$ x 23 " Fabric G strip to the top of the Fabric A strip. Sew the resulting strip to the top of Unit 1.
4. Sew (1) Unit 2 to each side of (1) 8" Fabric A square. Sew (1) $21 / 4 " \times 23$ " Fabric G strip to the bottom of the Fabric A strip. Sew the resulting strip to the bottom of Unit 1 to make the Center Block (Diagram 3).

5. Sew (1) $11 / 4 " \times 421 / 2$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 4$ " $24 \frac{1 / 2 "}{}$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block (Diagram 4).

6. Sew (1) $3^{1 / 2 "} \times 441 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $21 / 2 "$ x $301 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
7. Sew (1) Fabric B large triangle, (1) Fabric D small triangle and (1) Fabric E triangle together to make (1) Unit 3 (Diagram 5). Repeat to make (36) Unit 3's total.
8. Sew (1) Fabric D large triangle, (1) Fabric B small triangle and (1) Fabric E triangle together to make (1) Unit 4 (Diagram 6). Repeat to make (36) Unit 4's total.
9. Sew (2) Unit 3's and (2) Unit 4's together to make (1) Unit 5 (Diagram 7). Repeat to make (18) Unit 5's total.

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10. Sew (1) Fabric D large triangle, (1) Fabric B small triangle and (1) Fabric E triangle together to make (1) Unit 6 (Diagram 8). Repeat to make (16) Unit 6's total.
11. Sew (1) Fabric B large triangle, (1) Fabric D small triangle and (1) Fabric E triangle together to make (1) Unit 7 (Diagram 9). Repeat to make (16) Unit 7"s total.

12. Sew (2) Unit 6's and (2) Unit 7's together to make (1) Unit 8 (Diagram 10). Repeat to make (8) Unit 8's total.

13. Sew (5) Unit 5's together to make (1) Top/Bottom Border (Diagram 11). Repeat to make a second Top/Bottom Border.

14. Sew (8) Unit 5's together to make the Left Border (Diagram 12).
15. Sew (8) Unit 8's together to make the Right Border (Diagram 13).

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)
16. Sew the Left Border and the Right Border to the sides of the Center Block.
17. Sew (1) $61 / 2 "$ Fabric A square to each end of the (1) Top/Bottom Border. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

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18. Sew (1) $21 / 2$ " $\times 601 / 2$ " Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $21 / 2$ " x $461 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
19. Sew (1) $41 / 2$ " $\times 641 / 2$ " Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 541 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

## Finishing the Quilt

12. Layer and quilt as desired.
13. Sew the (7) Fabric B binding strips together, end to end with a 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
14. Bind as desired.
