Quilt finishes 100" x 100"

What a lovely tribute to our quiltmaking heritage. A smashing border print is the star of this reproduction antique quilt. Traditional "broderie perse" appliqué is used to add the nosegays to the center panel to make this eye-catching treasure.

**Note:** Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include 1/4" seam allowances. The mitered border includes extra length for insurance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 44" wide).

#### Fabric A

Fussy-cut (4) borders 21½" x 102", cut lengthwise (read step 3)

#### Fabric B

Fussy-cut (16) flowers (read step 2)

#### Fabric C

Cut (1) panel  $40\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $58\frac{1}{2}$ " Cut (2) panels  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $58\frac{1}{2}$ "

Cut (7) strips 2½" x 60", cut lengthwise for binding

#### **Backing**

Cut (3) panels 36" x 108", pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

### Making the Quilt

- 1. Referring to the quilt diagram, sew a Fabric C 91/2" panel to each side of the 40½" panel to make the background. Press seam allowances to one side.
- **2.** Cut 4 of each type of printed flower (16 flowers total), leaving an allowance of the white background around each. Turn under the white allowance and press so the flower seems to "float" with the white allowance surrounding it. Position the 16 flowers on the background as shown in the quilt photograph. Hand or machine stitch in place along the white edge.
- 3. Fussy-cut the 4 Fabric A borders lengthwise, two along each selvedge. Be sure that all borders are cut the same. Measure the quilt from top to bottom and side to side. Mark the middle of the borders and mark the border lengths to match the quilt's measurements. Pin the borders to the quilt, matching drawn marks with the middle and with the raw edges of the quilt. Pin every 3" along the border. Sew the borders to the quilt, starting and stopping stitching 1/4" from the quilt's raw edge. Hint: A walking foot helps keep the border from slipping. Miter the corners and trim the excess.


6 yards 7934-L Fabric B appliqué 1 yard 7935-L \*Fabric C 7938-L background 3½ yards Backing 9 yards 7937-L \*includes binding

### **Finishing the Quilt**

**4.** Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around the appliqué patches. Quilt around the printed motifs in the border. Echo quilt around the flowers, or quilt a grid or stippling to fill the space between the flowers. Bind to finish the quilt.




**Quilt Diagram**
