## Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42 " wide).

Fabric A Cut (2) $121 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (6) $81 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ strips.

Fabric B $\quad$ Cut (1) $121 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strips into (4) $81 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ strips.

Fabric C Cut (2) $121 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (6) $81 / 2 " \times 12^{1 / 2 "}$ strips.

Fabric D $\quad \operatorname{Cut}(1) 121 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2 "$ strips.

Fabric E Cut (4) $31 / 2$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut
(2) $31 / 2$ " $\times 661 / 2 "$ strips.

Cut (4) $31 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) $3^{1 / 2 "} \times 631 / 2 "$ strips.

Fabric F $\quad \operatorname{Cut}(10) 11 / 2 " \times 641 / 2 "$ strips from the length of fabric (LOF). Cut (2) $11 / 2$ " $\times 571 / 2$ " LOF strips. Cut (16) $11 / 2$ " $\times 81 / 2$ " strips from the remaining fabric.

Fabric G Cut (5) $31 / 2 " \times 641 / 2 "$ LOF strips.
Binding $\quad$ Cut (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips.
Backing Cut (2) 71 " $\times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 71 " x 80 " backing.

## Making the Quilt

## Quilt Top Assembly: <br> (Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)

Sew (4) $11 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric F strips, (3) $81 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$

1. Fabric A strips and (2) $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric B strips together to make one AB column. Repeat to make a second $A B$ column.

Sew (4) $11 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric F strips, (3) $81 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$
2. Fabric C strips and (2) $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric D strips together to make one CD column. Repeat to make a second CD column.

Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 641 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip to each side of (1)
3. $31 / 2 " \times 641 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to make (1) FG column. Repeat to make (5) FG columns total.
4. Sew the (5) FG columns, (2) AB columns and (2) CD columns together to make the quilt top.

Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 571 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F strip to the top and to the
5. bottom of the quilt top.

Sew (1) $3^{1 / 2 "} \times 66^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric E strip to each side of the quilt
6. top. Sew (1) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 631 / 2$ " Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.

## Finishing the Quilt

7. Layer and quilt as desired.
8. Sew the (7) $21 / 2$ " $x$ WOF binding strips together, end to end with a 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in halflengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
9. Bind as desired.
