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## Santa's Little Helper Quilt

Quilt finishes 60" x 60" Pillow finishes 18" x 18"

Santa and his little helper, the red and green caterpillar from the beloved children's book, are the center of this medallion-style quilt. Fun novelty prints and easy patchwork make the quilt a delight to construct. Stitch a pillow using the leftover fabrics for additional enjoyment.

#### **Cutting Directions**

**Note:** Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include \(^1/4''\) seam allowances. Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus \(^1/4''\) seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42'' wide).

#### [Cutting in brackets is for the pillow.]

Fabric A	Fussy-cut (1) panel 21½" x 21½" from Santa print
	[Fussy-cut (1) panel $16\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ " from tree print]

**Fabric B** Fussy-cut (2) borders 4½" x 40½", cut lengthwise, centering words

Fabric C Fussy-cut (4) squares 4½", centering snowflakes

**Fabric D** Cut (4) squares  $6\frac{1}{2}$ "

**Fabric E** Cut (2) borders  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $32\frac{1}{2}$ ", cut crosswise

**Fabric F** Cut (28) squares  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " [Cut 4 squares  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " for border corners]

Fabric G Cut (2) borders 2" x 241/2", cut crosswise

Cut (2) borders 2" x 211/2", cut crosswise

Cut (28) squares 4½"

Cut (12) circles with 2" diameter for appliqué

[Cut 32 squares 1½" for border]

**Fabric H** Cut (24) squares 4½"

Cut (12) circles with 2" diameter for appliqué

[Cut 32 squares 1½" for border]

**Fabric I** Cut (4) borders  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $40\frac{1}{2}$ ", cut crosswise

Cut (7) strips 2½" x WOF for binding

Cut (4) appliqué stars

**Backing** Cut (2) panels 34" x 68", pieced to fit quilt top

with overlap on all sides

[Cut 1 panel 20" x 20" for pillow back]

## **Making the Quilt**

- 1. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, sew Fabric G borders to the center 21½" square, sides on first.
- 2. To fuse the appliqué, draw 2"-diameter circles onto the paper side of paper-backed fusible web. Following manufacturer's instructions, fuse patterns to the wrong side of Fabrics G and H. Cut out circles on the drawn lines. Center and fuse circles on 24 Fabric F 4½" squares. Finish the edges with a decorative machine stitch using contrasting thread, or use an invisible thread with a blind appliqué machine stitch.
- 3. Sew 6 Fabric F squares side by side, alternating the color of circles as shown.

  Make 4 Border 2 like this. Sew 2 borders to sides of the quilt. Sew Fabric C squares to ends of remaining pieced borders. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.
- **4.** For Border 3, sew Fabric E borders to the sides. Sew Fabric B borders to the top and bottom.
- **5.** For Border 4, sew 2 Fabric I borders to the sides. Sew Fabric D squares to ends of other 2 Fabric I borders. Sew to the top and bottom.

with 6 Fabric G squares alternately with 6 Fabric H squares to make Border 5. Make 4. Sew to sides of the quilt. Center and fuse Fabric I stars to Fabric F 4½" squares. Finish star edges the same as the appliquéd circles. Sew the appliquéd squares to ends of remaining pieced Border 5's. Sew to the top and bottom.

## **Finishing the Quilt**


7. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders and block patches. Quilt around the appliqué patches. Bind to finish the quilt.

### **Making the Pillow**

Stuff pillow and stitch the

opening closed.

- 1. Join 8 Fabric G 1½" squares alternately with 8 Fabric H squares to make a border. Make 4. Sew 2 borders to sides of the quilt, orienting the colors as shown. Sew Fabric F 1½" squares to ends of remaining borders. Sew to the top and bottom.
- 2. Center and pin the pillow top to the backing, right sides together. The backing will stick out a little beyond the pillow. Sew around the pillow, leaving a 4" opening along one side. Trim corners and backing. Turn pillow right side out.
