Introducing Andover Fabrics new collection: SEASONS BEST - SUMMER by Kim Schaefer Quilt designed by Jean Ann Wright

Quilt finishes 48' x 56"
Change your quilt décor for every season with four endearing quilts in the Season's Best series. The smiling sun faces in the Summer Quilt version are easy fusible appliqué, and the floral panels will look like appliqué once they are quilted. Because the quilts are the same size, it will be easy to interchange them on your wall.

## Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances. A fat $1 / 8$ is an $9^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}-22^{\prime \prime}$ cut. A fat $1 / 4$ is an $18^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}-22^{\prime \prime}$ cut. Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus $1 / 4$ " seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide).

## Fabric A

Fussy-cut (3) panels $7^{1} 12^{\prime \prime} \times 421^{1 / 2 \prime}$, centering motifs

## Fabric B

Cut (4) corner squares $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Fabric C

Cut (2) side borders $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 46^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$, cut crosswise and pieced
Cut (2) top/bottom borders $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3812^{\prime \prime}$, cut crosswise

## Fabric D

Fussy-cut (2) side borders $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 441 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut crosswise and pieced Fussy-cut (2) top/bottom borders $11^{\prime \prime} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 38^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}}$
Fabric E Cut (4) rectangles 5" x $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric F Cut (6) sashes $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{1 / 2 \prime}$, cut crosswise
Cut (2) top/bottom borders $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 361 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric G Cut (14) sun faces
Fabric H Cut (14) sun backs
Fabric I Cut (4) rectangles 5" x 6¹/2"

> Cut (28) eyes

Fabric J Cut (2) rectangles 5" x 61/2"
Fabric K Cut (4) rectangles 5" x 6¹⁄2"
Fabric L Cut (28) cheeks
Fabric MCut (6) strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF for binding


## Backing

Cut (2) panels $33^{\prime \prime} \times 56^{\prime \prime}$, pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

## Making the Quilt

1. Fussy-cut the 3 panels from Fabric A, referring to the quilt photo. Be sure to include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance to ensure the same amount of printed "framing" is around all sides. The width should be approximately $71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Set aside.
2. Make acrylic templates of each sun appliqué shape. Trace the motifs onto the paper side of paper-backed fusible web. Note that each sun back is cut as one piece from Fabric H. Following manufacturer's instructions, fuse traced patterns to the wrong side of the appropriate fabrics. Cut out patches on the drawn lines. Center each sun back, sun, and sun face on the $5^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{1 / 2 \prime}$ "rectangles. Fuse in place. Use tear-away stabilizer on the back of the rectangle to prevent distortion. Finish the edges with a decorative machine stitch using contrasting thread, or use an invisible thread with a blind appliqué machine stitch.
Remove the tear-away. Embroider each mouth with embroidery floss or use a narrow machine zigzag stitch. Make 14 Sun Blocks.s.
3. Arrange the appliqued Sun Blocks in 2 vertical rows of 7 blocks each, referring to the quilt diagram for fabric placement. Join the blocks.
4. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, sew Fabric F sashes to long sides of each Fabric A panel from Step 1. Press seam allowances toward the sashes. Sew the 2 appliqué rows between the 3 printed panels. Press seam allowances toward the sashes. Sew Fabric F borders to the top and bottom of the quilt.
5. Sew Fabric D borders to the sides, and then to the top and bottom.
6. Sew Fabric C side borders to the quilt. Sew Fabric B corner squares to the ends of remaining borders and sew to the top and bottom.

## Finishing the Quilt

7. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders and block patches. Quilt around the printed motifs in the Fabric A panels and outer border. Quilt around the appliqué. Bind to finish the quilt.
