


Frolicking snow girls and boys are the focus of this bright and breezy table runner that is sure to delight everyone who sees it. The appealing design is as easy as one-two-three, so you may wish to make several for holiday gifting as well as for yourself.

Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include 1/4" seam allowances. A fat 1/8 is a 9" x 20"-21" cut of fabric. A fat 1/4 is an 18" x 20"-21" cut. Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus 1/4" seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric B	Cut (2) strips 4½" x 14½"
Fabric C	Cut (2) strips 4½" x 14½"
Fabric D	Cut (1) strip 8½" x 14½"
Fabric E	Cut (2) strips 4½" x 14½"
Fabric F	Cut (2) strips 2½" x 14½"
Fabric G	Cut (2) strips 2½" x 14½"
Fabric H	Cut (2) strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ "
Fabric I	Cut (5) strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for binding Cut (2) strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ "
Backing	Cut (1) panel 30" x 64"



Making the Quilt

- 1. Look at the quilt photograph to see where to fussy-cut the striped print to obtain the 5½"-wide border strips. Cut side borders from the snowman stripe and top and bottom borders from the tree stripe.
- Referring to the Quilt Diagram, sew the 2½", 4½", and 8½" strips in the order shown.
 Press seam allowances open or in one direction.
- **3.** Sew the side borders in place, turning the snow people print as shown. Sew the tree borders to the top and bottom, turning the print as shown.

Finishing the Quilt

4. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders and patches. Quilt around the printed motifs as you wish. Bind to finish the quilt.
