Quilt finishes 44" x 53"
The stork has a very special delivery to make to the cabbage patch in this cute baby quilt panel. There is double the fun if he delivers twins! You can get in on the fun by making this quick and easy baby quilt for your own very Special Delivery!

## Fabric Requirements

| Fabric A | quilt center | $2 / 3$ yard | $4960-\mathrm{M}$ |
| Fabric B | outer border | $13 / 3$ yards | $4964-\mathrm{G}$ |
| Fabric C | inner border | $1 / 2$ yards | $4967-\mathrm{L}$ |
| Fabric D | pieced border | $1 / 4$ yard | $4961-\mathrm{P}$ |
| Fabric E | pieced border | $1 / 3$ yard | $4962-\mathrm{Y}$ |
| Fabric F | pieced border | $1 / 3$ yard | $4963-\mathrm{B}$ |
| Fabric G | pieced border | $1 / 3$ yard | $4965-\mathrm{Y}$ |
| Fabric H | binding | $1 / 2$ yard | $4966-\mathrm{G}$ |
| Fabric I | backing | $31 / 2$ yards | $4961-\mathrm{G}$ |

## Cutting Directions

Fabric A Cut (1) panel $221 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 321 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric B Cut (2) strips $6^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut lengthwise
Cut (2) strips $6^{\prime \prime} \times 441 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut lengthwise
Fabric C Cut (2) strips 3" x $321 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Cut (2) strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 271 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric D Cut (4) squares $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric E Cut (14) squares $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric F Cut (14) squares $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric G Cut (14) squares $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric H Cut (5) strips 21/2" x WOF
Backing Cut (2) panels $42^{\prime \prime} \times 61^{\prime \prime}$, pieced to fit quilt top with 4 " overlap on all sides

## Making and Assembling the Quilt

1. Refer to the Assembly Diagram throughout.
2. Sew the $32^{1} / 2$ " fabric $C$ border strips to the long sides and the $271 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ fabric $C$ border strips to the top and bottom of the center panel. Press seam allowances toward the fabric C strips.
3. Join one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square each of fabric G , fabric E and fabric F to make a G-E-F border unit. Press seam allowances in one direction. Repeat to make eight G-E-F border units.


## Border Unit - Make 8

4. Join four G-E-F border units to make a side border strip. Repeat to make two side border strips. Press seam allowances in one direction.
5. Sew a side border strip to opposite long sides of the bordered center panel. Press seam allowances toward the fabric C border strips.
6. Join one $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square each of fabric G , fabric F and fabric E to make a G-F-E border unit. Press seam allowances in one direction. Repeat to make six G-F-E border units.

7. Repeat step 4 with three G-F-E border units to make two border strips. Sew a $31 / 2$ " fabric D square to each end of each strip. Press seam allowances toward the fabric D squares. Sew these strips to the top and bottom of the bordered center panel. Press seam allowances toward the fabric C border strips.


Top and Bottom Border Strip - Make 2
8. Sew the $421 / 2 "$ fabric B border strips to the long sides and the $441 / 2$ fabric B border strips to the top and bottom of the bordered center panel to complete the quilt top.
Press seam allowances toward the fabric B border strips.

## Finishing the Quilt

9. Layer quilt top with batting and backing. Quilt in the ditch of seams and as desired. Bind to finish the quilt.
