

Fabric D Cut (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric E Cut (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut

> (2) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x 49" strips. Cut (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 31" strips.

Cut (2) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (8) 3" x 5 1/2" strips and

(2) 3" squares.

Fabric J Cut (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

Backing Cut (2) 52" x WOF strips. Sew the strips

together and trim to make (1) 52" x 72"




Making the Quilt

1. Block Assembly

Sew (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 43" Fabric B strip to each side of the 23" x 43" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square to each end of (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 23" Fabric B strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel to make (1) A-Block (Diagram 1).



2. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 49" Fabric E strip to each side of the A-Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 31" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the A-Block. Trim the block to measure 30 ½" x 50 ½" to make the Center Block (Diagram 2).



3. Place (1) 3" Fabric C square on the right side of (1) 3" x 5 ½" Fabric F strip, right sides together (Diagram 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 4). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance.

4. Place another 3" Fabric C square on the left side of the 3" x 5 ½" Fabric F strip, right sides together (Diagram 5). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Diagram 5). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 6). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make (1) CFC unit.

- **5.** Repeat Steps 3-4 to make (4) CFC units total.
- 6. Place (1) 1½" Fabric C square on the top left corner of (1) 3" Fabric F square, right sides together (Diagram 7). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Diagram 7). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Diagram 8). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ¼" away from the sewn seam.

7. Follow Diagram 9 for the seam direction to add a 1½" Fabric C square to the upper right corner of the 3" Fabric F square to make (1) F block (Diagram 10).








8. Repeat Steps 6-7 to make (8) F blocks total.




9. Sew (2) F blocks together to make (1) strip. Sew this strip to the top of (1) CFC unit to make (1) Block One (Diagram 11). Repeat to make (4) Block Ones total.




10. Repeat Steps 3-9 using Diagrams 12-15 for fabric identification and location to make (8) Block Twos, (8) Block Threes, (8) Block Fours and (4) Block Fives.










Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.)

- **11.** Sew (10) assorted Blocks together. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the Center Block.
- **12.** Sew (6) assorted Blocks together. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) 5 ½" Fabric B square to each end of the strips. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- **13.** Sew (1) 2 ½" x 60 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

Finishing the Quilt

- 14. Layer and quilt as desired.
- **15.** Sew the (6) Fabric J binding strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 16. Bind as desired.


