Quilt finishes 64' x 80' 48 Blocks: 8" x 8"

This scrappy twin-size quilt will make you smile as you choose the combinations of novelty print rectangles for the simple Split Snowball blocks. The prints are an homage to the beloved children's book first printed in 1969. Generations of children have delighted in the story of the caterpillar who eats and eats his way to becoming a butterfly.

## Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances. A fat $1 / 8$ is a $9^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}-22^{\prime \prime}$ cut of fabric. A fat $1 / 4$ is an $18^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}-22^{\prime \prime}$ cut. Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus ${ }^{1 / 4} 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide).
Fabric A Cut (8) strips $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF for binding
Fabric B Cut (2) borders $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 64 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut crosswise and pieced Cut (2) borders $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 521 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut crosswise and pieced Cut (192) squares $2^{1 / 2 \prime} \times 2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ for block corners

Fabric C Cut (2) borders $61^{1 / 2 \prime} \times 68^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut lengthwise
Cut (2) borders $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 641 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut lengthwise
5 "Solids" From each: Cut (8-12) rectangles $4^{1 / 2 \prime 2} \times 8^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ (a total of 48)
2 Fat $1 / 4^{\prime}$ 's Cut (6) squares $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from each
12 Fat $1 / 8$ 's From each:
Cut (1-4) rectangles $41^{1 / 2 \prime} \times 8^{1 / 2 \prime}($ a total of 36$)$
Backing Cut (2) panels $36^{\prime \prime} \times 88^{\prime \prime}$, pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

## Making the Quilt

1. Refer to the Quilt Diagram and quilt photograph for fabric combinations. Join a Fat $1 / 8$ or a Fat $1 / 4$ rectangle and a "solid" fabric rectangle to make a square. Press the seam allowance toward the "solid" fabric. The square should measure $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ in all directions. If it does not, adjust your stitching and pressing methods. Make 48 squares like this.
2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each Fabric B $2^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ square. Referring to Diagram 1, place a marked square on a pieced $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square with right sides together, aligning raw edges at the corner. Stitch on the drawn line; trim away and discard excess fabric. Press open. Repeat on the opposite corner, watching orientation of the sewing. Repeat on the remaining corners (Diagram 2). Make a total of 48 blocks.

3. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, arrange 6 blocks in each of 8 horizontal rows, turning blocks as shown so odd-numbered rows have "solid" fabric rectangles on the right side of the blocks. In even-numbered rows, the "solid" fabric is on the left side of each block. Join the blocks to make 8 rows. Join the rows.
4. Sew long Fabric B borders to the sides. Sew short Fabric $B$ borders to the top and bottom. Repeat to add the Fabric C borders.

## Finishing the Quilt

5. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders and block patches. Quilt around the printed motifs in the blocks and outer border. Bind to finish the quilt.
