Notes

- Seams are 1/4" throughout unless stated otherwise.
- · Read pattern in full before starting.
- Press fabrics before cutting.
- Press after each seam.
- WOF = width of fabric a strip of fabric cut from selvedge to selvedge

1 Making the wall hanging and pillow top


- 1.1 Cut the fabrics, fusible web and wadding into the WOF strips and then the individual pieces listed in the table at the top of the pattern.
- 1.2 Trace the mirror letters spelling HOME SWEET HOME for the wall hanging and HOME for the pillow onto the 4" x 5" fusible web rectangles and twenty-two hearts onto the fusible web squares.
- 1.3 Fuse the fusible web rectangle letters to the back of the 4" x 5" rectangles of letter fabric and the fusible web heart squares to the back of the 4" heart fabric squares.
- 1.4 Cut out the letters and hearts and remove the backing paper from each.
- 1.5 Fuse each letter and each heart to one of the 4 ½" x 5 ½" background fabric rectangles.
- 1.6 Stitch around the edge of each letter and each heart using your preferred decorative stitch such as zigzag or blanket stitch.
- 1.7 For the wall hanging, sew the background rectangles into five rows as shown in the left hand diagram below and press seams. For the pillow, sew them into four rows as shown in the right hand diagram below and press seams.



1.8 Sew those rows together and trim the ends of the longer rows on the wall hanging top.



1.9 Sash the sides of the pillow top with the shorter then the top and bottom with the longer border 1 strip. Repeat with the border 2 strips.






2 Finishing the wall hanging


- 2.1 Make and baste a quilt sandwich using the backing fabric, batting and wall hanging top and quilt as desired. Trim wadding and backing to the size of the wall hanging top.
- 2.2 Sew the binding fabric strips end to end using diagonal or straight seams as preferred and fold in half along the length wrong sides together to make a double fold binding. Cut off three 6" lengths.
- 2.3 Press the edges of the 6" lengths to the centre then fold in half to make strips with raw edges hidden.
- 2.4 Fold in half and pin two to each end of the top of the wall hanging and one in the middle of the top on the back of the quilt so that the raw edges will be hidden within the binding and the loops point towards the bottom of the wall hanging. These will then fold up to make hanging loops when the binding is sewn on.
- 2.5 Bind to finish, taking care to mitre corners and to sew the hanging loops in place.

3 Finishing the pillow

- 3.1 Baste the pillow top and the two pieces of pillow backing fabric to the corresponding pieces of wadding. In the case of the pillow back pieces, fold a 1" overhang of fabric to the back of the wadding along the long side of each. **NB:** we did not back our wadding to make these pillows but backing fabric could be added if preferred cut to the same size as the pieces of wadding.
- 3.2 Quilt each piece as desired and trim wadding (and backing fabric if used) to the size of the pillow top and pillow back pieces.
- 3.3 Pin the three pieces together, right sides together with the narrower back piece overlapping the wider piece and with the folded edges forming the envelope edges of the pillow.
- 3.4 Sew the pillow front and backs together using a ½" seam, clip corners and turn inside out to finish.


