3674-Y 2 yards (Block Corner Triangles) Mustard/Gold Dot Print

Cut (90) 5-1/8" squares, cut in half diagonally to make 180 half-square triangles

#### 3670-K 2-1/2 yards (Vertical Strips)

Black Large Star/Paisley Stripe Cut (6) 5" x 82", cut on lengthwise grain,

centered on small star line

WV-2869-N 5 yards (Backing) Cut and piece lengthwise to fit quilt top, with 4" overlap on all sides.

3671-K 3/4 yard (Binding)

Black/Brown Arced Triangle Print Cut (8) 2-1/2" x width of fabric strips

#### **Block Cutting Directions**

This quilt features 9 different blocks: Nine Patch, Railroad Crossing, Card Trick, Sawtooth Star, Friendship Star, Churn Dash, Double Pinwheel, Cake Stand, and King's Crown. All blocks **finish** at 8-1/2" square.

Note: Cutting directions are for 1 block. You'll be making 5 blocks of each type for a total of 45 blocks. The cutting directions refer to lights and medium/darks. Reverse lights and darks as you wish and remember that what is a medium in one block may appear light when paired up with a dark fabric. Different color combinations make for a truly rich and scrappy quilt, so have fun and mix your fabrics your way!

#### Nine Patch

From lights cut: (4) 2-1/2" squares From mediums/darks cut: (5) 2-1/2" squares

#### **Railroad Crossing**

- From lights cut:
  - (1) 3-7/8'' square
  - (4) 2" squares
- From mediums/darks cut:
  - (1) 3-7/8'' square
  - (4) 2" squares

#### Card Trick

#### From light cut:

- 3-1/4" square, cut in half twice diagonally for 4 quarter square triangles
  2.7/8" squares
- (2) 2-7/8'' squares
- From 1st medium/dark cut:
  - (1) 3-1/4" square, cut in half twice diagonally for 4 quarter square triangles
  - (2) 2-7/8" squares, *one* cut in half diagonally to make 2 half-square triangles
- From 2nd medium/dark cut:
  - (1) 3-1/4" square, cut in half twice diagonally for 4 quarter square triangles
  - (2) 2-7/8" squares, *one* cut in half diagonally to make 2 half-square triangles

#### Sawtooth Star

- From lights cut:
  - (4)  $2 \cdot 1/2'' \ge 3 \cdot 1/2''$  rectangles
  - (4) 2" squares

#### From mediums/darks cut:

- (8) 2" squares
- (1) 3-1/2'' squares

#### Friendship Star

From lights cut:

- (4) 2-1/2'' squares
- (2) 2-7/8'' squares

#### From mediums/darks cut:

- (1) 2-1/2" square (block center)
- (2) 2-7/8" squares

#### Churn Dash

#### From lights cut:

- (2) 2-7/8'' squares
- (1) 2-1/2" square (block center)
- (1) 1-1/2" x 14" strip
- From mediums/darks cut:
  - (2) 2-7/8'' squares
  - (1)  $1-1/2'' \ge 14''$  strip

#### **Double Pinwheel**

#### From lights cut:

- (1) 4-1/4" square, cut in half twice diagonally to make 4 quarter-square triangles
- From mediums/darks cut:
  - (2) 3-7/8" squares, cut in half diagonally to make 4 half-square triangles
  - (1) 4-1/4" square, cut in half twice diagonally to make 4 quarter-square triangles

#### Cake Stand

From lights cut:

- (1) 3-7/8" square, cut in half diagonally to make 2 half-square triangles
- (2)  $2'' \times 3 \frac{1}{2}''$  rectangles
- (2) 2-3/8" squares
- (1) 2'' square
- From mediums/darks cut:
  - (1) 3-7/8" square, cut in half diagonally to make 2 half-square triangles (one will be left over)
  - (3) 2-3/8" squares, *one* cut in half to make 2 half-square triangles.

#### King's Crown

#### From lights cut:


- (1) 3-1/2'' square
- (8) 2" squares
- From mediums/darks cut
  - (4) 2" squares
  - (4)  $2'' \times 3 1/2''$  rectangles

### Yorktown Strippy Sampler

#### **Block Assembly**

Note: Throughout block assembly, use draw, stitch, cut, and press method from Step 2 (below) whenever triangle squares are part of a block.


1. Stitch 4 light and 5 dark squares together to make Nine Patch Block (Diagram 1). Make 5 total



2. Referring to Diagram 2-A, draw diagonal line on wrong side of light 3-7/8" square and place,



right sides together, on dark 3-7/8" square. Sew 1/4" to each side of drawn line. Cut apart on line and press open to make 2 triangle squares. Stitch 4-patch units as shown (Diagram 2-B). Sew triangle squares and 4-patch units together to make Railroad Crossing Block (Diagram 2-C). Make 5 total.



3. Stitch 2-7/8" triangle squares and triangles together, watching placement closely, to make Card Trick Block (Diagram 3). Make 5 total.




4. Referring to Diagram 4-A, draw diagonal line on wrong side of medium/dark 2" square. Place on light 2" x 3-1/2" rectangle, right sides together, raw edges aligned. Stitch together on marked line, trim, and press open. Repeat on other end of rectangle to make flying goose. Make 4. Complete Sawtooth Star Block as shown (Diagram 4-B). Make 5 total.



5. Sew 2-7/8" triangle squares and 2-1/2" squares together to make Friendship Star (Diagram 5). Make 5 total.

6. Sew light and dark 14" strips together, press in direction of arrow and cut segments as indicated (Diagram 6-A). Referring to Diagram 6-B, stitch 2-7/8"





triangle squares, segments, and matching 2-1/2" square together to make Churn Dash Block. Make 5 total.



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Assembling the Quilt Referring to Quilt Diagram, stitch 5 block columns of 9 blocks each. Trimming even after each addition, sew black paisley 5" x 82" strips and block columns together, alternating.

**Finishing the Quilt** Layer quilt with batting and WV-2869-N backing. Quilt as desired. Bind with 3671-K black/brown arced triangle print to finish the quilt.
