Quilt finishes 52' x 66'
12 Blocks: 12' x 12'"
Contrasting light and dark traditional prints, framed with soft green sashes, make a charming throw-size quilt. The traditional Chimney Sweep blocks, popular in the 1920s and 1930s, are perfect for this homage to our quilting ancestors.

## Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances. A fat $1 / 8$ is a $9^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}-22^{\prime \prime}$ cut. Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide).

## Fabric A

Cut (2) side borders $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 541 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut lengthwise
Cut (2) top/bottom borders borders $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $441 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut lengthwise
Cut (17) sashes $2^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}} \times 12^{1 / 2 \prime}$

## Fabric B

Cut (6) setting squares $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Fabric C

Cut (2) side borders $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 58 \frac{1}{2 \prime} 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut lengthwise
Cut (2) top/bottom borders $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 52^{1 / 2 \prime}$, cut lengthwise Cut patches for 3 blocks (see 3 Lights list)

## Fabric D

Cut (6) strips $21 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF for binding
Cut patches for 1 block (see 11 Darks list)

## 3 Lights

Cut patches for 3 blocks from each:
Cut (6) rectangles $25 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 67 / 8^{\prime \prime}$
Cut (18) rectangles $25 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 43 / 4^{\prime \prime}$
Cut (6) squares $25 / \mathbf{8}^{\prime \prime}$

## 11 Darks

Cut patches for 1 block from each:
Cut (3) squares $41 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, cut in half diagonally twice to make 12 quarter-square triangles
Cut (1) rectangle $25 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 67 / 8^{\prime \prime}$
Cut (2) squares $25 / \mathbf{s}^{\prime \prime}$
Cut (2) squares $23 / \mathbf{s}^{\prime \prime}$, cut in half diagonally to make 4 half-square triangles

## Backing

Cut (2) panels $37^{\prime \prime} \times 60^{\prime \prime}$, pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

## Making the Quilt

1. Referring to the Block diagram, sew dark patches to the light rectangles and squares to make rows. Press seam allowances toward the dark patches. Join the rows to make a block. Make 12 blocks.
2. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, arrange the blocks in rows. Join 3 blocks alternately with 2 sashes to make a block row. Make 4.
3. Join 3 sashes alternately with 2 Fabric B squares to make a sash row. Make 3. Join the rows in the order shown.
4. Sew longer Fabric A borders to the sides, and sew shorter borders to top and bottom. Repeat with Fabric C borders.

## Finishing the Quilt

5. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders and block patches. Bind to finish the quilt.
