

Introducing Andover Fabrics new collection: PATRIOTIC for Quilts of Valor Foundation Quilt designed by Jean Ann Wright

Quilt finishes 60" x 80"

Pay tribute to our military with this inspiring stars and stripes quilt. The fabric collection honors the non-profit organization that has donated more than 100,000 quilts to comfort our returning heroes who have been touched by war. Because of the ease of construction, you may want to make this stirring quilt for a family member and another to donate to the foundation.

Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include ½" seam allowances. Borders include extra length for insurance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A	Fussy-cut (4) squares approximately 201/2" x 201/2"
	(read step 1 before cutting)

Fabric B Fussy-cut (2) borders $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x 72", cut crosswise and pieced Fussy-cut (2) borders $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x 62", cut crosswise and pieced

Cut (2) borders $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 52", cut crosswise and pieced

Cut (12) rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "

Fabric G Cut (2) borders 4" x 48", cut crosswise and pieced

(cut slightly wider than needed)

Cut (2) borders 4" x 44", cut crosswise and pieced

Fabric H Cut (12) rectangles 2½" x 4½"

Fabric I Cut (24) rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "

Cut (24) squares 2½" x 2½"

Backing Cut (2) panels 34" x 88", pieced to fit

quilt top with overlap on all sides



Making the Quilt

1. Cut each panel into 2 squares approximately 20½" x 20½". Refer to the quilt photograph to see where to cut the motif, adding ¼" seam allowance beyond the portion that you want to show in your quilt. The size of a square isn't as important as fussy-cutting the motif to obtain the design shown. Cut each of the 4 squares alike. Join the squares to make the center, rotating them as shown. Press seam allowances open. The center should measure approximately 40½", but don't worry if it is slightly larger or smaller.



Fabric C Cut (8) strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for binding Cut (12) rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "

Fabric D Cut (10) rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "

Fabric E Cut (22) rectangles 2½" x 4½" Cut (22) squares 2½" x 2½"


- **2.** Sew short Fabric G borders to sides of the pieced center. Trim ends even with the quilt. Sew long borders to top and bottom and trim. Trim the quilt to the correct size in step 4.
- **3.** Referring to the Unit 1-4 Diagrams, join patches to make the number of units indicated. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, join 23 units in the order shown to make a pieced border. Make 2 borders just alike.
- **4.** After pressing, measure the pieced border from end to end. It should measure approximately $46\frac{1}{2}$ " long. Trim the quilt center with Fabric G borders this measurement, centering the printed panels so the Fabric G borders are the

same width all around. Sew a pieced border from step 3 to the quilt top, turning it as shown. Sew the other pieced border to the bottom, rotating it as shown.

5. Sew long Fabric F borders to the sides. Trim each border even with the quilt's sides after it is added to the quilt. Sew short Fabric F borders to top and bottom. Repeat with the Fabric B borders.

Finishing the Quilt


6. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders and pieced border patches. Quilt around the printed motifs in center panels and outer border. Bind to finish the quilt.
