

This two-block wall quilt honors perhaps the most vital insect in our world, the bee. Beekeepers use coiled straw baskets, called Skeps, to create a cozy home for bees. In the quilt, the Beehive Block alternates with the time-honored Honey Bee block with its fusible appliqué. Choose from four colorways.

Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances. A fat $\frac{1}{4}$ is a 9" x 20"-22" cut of fabric. A fat $\frac{1}{4}$ is an 18" x 20"-22" cut. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).





Cut (16) squares $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " for Honey Bee Blocks

Cut (5) patches 11/2" x 51/2" for Beehive Blocks

Fabric X

Cut (5) patches 1½" x 6½" for Beehive Blocks

Making the Quilt


- in this quilt to add the little corners to the rectangles in the Beehive Block.

 Draw a diagonal line on the back side of 1" background squares. Position a marked square as shown on one end of the appropriate rectangle (Diagram 1). Stitch on the marked diagonal line. Do not cut away the excess fabric. Press the corner up. Repeat this step on the opposite end of the rectangle. Add background corners to each 1" wide rectangle in the Beehive Blocks.
- 2. Refer to the Beehive Block piecing diagram. Join 1" rectangles to the appropriate 1½" rectangles to make 4 pieced units. Sew the background rectangles to ends of each pieced unit.

 Join these to make the center of the block.
- 3. Handle (Diagrams on page 6): Join a 1½" square background fabric to a 1½" square beehive fabric. Press seam to dark side and trim center unit to 1¼" x 2½" (Diagram 2). Sew the beehive fabric 1½" x 2½" rectangles to sides of the center unit. Press seams away from center, and trim width to 2½", measuring 1¼" from center of unit (Diagram 3). The unit should measure 2½" x 2½", raw edge to edge.

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the background 1%" squares. Place a square in each top corner of unit, wrong sides together, and sew on line (Diagram 4). Trim excess fabric from seams and press towards the corner. Trim %" from top and bottom of unit to measure 2%" wide x 2" high including seam allowance (Diagram 5). Join the background fabric 1" x 2%" rectangle to the top. Sew the 2%" x 4%" background patches to the sides as shown in the Block Piecing diagram. Sew this unit to the partial block from Step 2.

4. Join patches to make the base and "feet" of the beehive. Sew to the bottom of the block.



Black/Taupe Quilt




Make 5 Beehive Blocks.


- 5. Join the 2" square patches to make the Nine Patch center of the Honey Bee Block. Sew other patches in rows and join all to make the block. Make 4 Honeybee blocks.
- **6.** These directions are for fusible applique. If you wish to stitch the raw edge of the applique, use a lightweight fusible webbing. If you do not plan to stitch it, use a heavyweight fusible. On the paper side of the fusible webbing, trace the petals, aligning the dashed lines. Cut around the petals loosely. Follow manufacturer's directions to fuse the webbing to the back side of the appropriate fabric. Cut out along the drawn lines. Remove the paper backing. Fuse the petals to the block, noting placement at the corners of the center Nine Patch. Finish with machine stitching as desired.
- 7. Referring to the Quilt Assembly, arrange the blocks in 3 rows of 3 blocks each, noting placement. Position the sashes and setting squares in place.


 Join the blocks and sashes into 3 block rows. Join sashes and setting squares into 4 sash rows. Finally, join the rows as shown.

Finishing the Quilt


8. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around sashes and patches. Quilt around the hive and the petals as you wish. Bind to finish the quilt.








Honey Bee Block - Make 4
