

This runner is the perfect project to welcome Fall into your home!

Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus ¼" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A	Cut (1) 13 $\frac{1}{4}$ " square. Cut the square
	across both diagonals to make
	(4) triangles. Note: Only (3)
	triangles will be used.

Fabric B Cut (1) 13 ¼" square. Cut the square across both diagonals to make (4) triangles. Note: Only (3) triangles will be used.

Fabric C	Cut (1) $13\frac{1}{4}$ " square. Cut the square
	across both diagonals to make
	(4) triangles. Note: Only (3)
	triangles will be used.

Fabric D	Cut (1) 13 1/4" square. Cut the square
	across both diagonals to make
	(4) triangles. Note: Only (3)
	triangles will be used.

Cut (2) 1" x 37 ½" WOF strips. Cut (1) 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 1" x 12 ½" strips. Cut (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding. See instructions to cut (1) Small Leaf.

Needed for applique:

1 Pack of LBQ-0329-S Maple Leaves Fusible Applique Shapes.

Fabric I* See instructions to cut (1) Small Leaf.

Backing Cut (1) 17" x 42" WOF strip for the back.

You will also need:

(1) Pack of LBQ-0329-S (pre-cut leaves)

Making the Runner

1. Block Assembly

Sew together (1) Fabric A triangle, (1) Fabric B triangle, (1) Fabric C triangle and (1) Fabric D triangle as shown in Diagram 1 to make (1) Block One square. The block should measure 12 ½" x 12 ½".





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2. Sew together (1) Fabric A triangle, (1) Fabric B triangle, (1) Fabric C triangle and (1) Fabric D triangle as shown in Diagram 2 to make (1) Block Two square. The block should measure 12 ½" x 12 ½".



- 3. Sew together (1) Fabric A triangle, (1) Fabric B triangle, (1) Fabric C triangle and (1) Fabric D triangle as shown in Diagram 3 to make (1) Block Three square. The block should measure 12 ½" x 12 ½".

Runner Top Assembly


(Refer to the Runner Layout when assembling the runner top.)

4. Sew the (3) blocks together in numerical order to make the Center Block.


- **5.** Sew (1) 1" x 12 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1" x 37 ½" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block (Diagram 4).
- **6.** Refer to the runner layout to arrange and press the (6) pre-cut leaves onto the Center Block.
- 7. If pre-cut leaves were not purchased, follow the manufacturer's instructions and trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- **8.** Press the leaves onto the Center Block as shown in the Runner Layout.
- **9.** Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make the runner top.

Finishing the Runner

- 10. Layer and quilt runner as desired.
- **11.** Sew the (3) Fabric E binding strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 12. Bind as desired.



Runner Layout


