

Quilt Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting

patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus ¹/₄" seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42" wide).

Fabric A	Cut (3) 6 ¹ / ₂ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (10) 6 ¹ / ₂ " x 8 ¹ / ₂ " strips. Cut (2) 3 ¹ / ₂ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (10) 3 ¹ / ₂ " x 6 ¹ / ₂ " strips.	F F F F F F
Fabric B	Cut (4) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (20) 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips.	F E
Fabric C	Cut (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (10) 3 ½" x 5 ½" strips.	Fal
Fabric D	Cut (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (10) 3 ½" x 5 ½" strips.	
Fabric E	Cut (2) 4 ¹ / ₂ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (10) 4 ¹ / ₂ " squares.	
Fabric F	Cut (3) 4 ¹ / ₂ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (10) 4 ¹ / ₂ " x 8 ¹ / ₂ " strips.	Fal Fal
Fabric G	Cut (2) 3 ¹ / ₂ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (10) 3 ¹ / ₂ " x 6 ¹ / ₂ " strips.	
Fabric H	Cut (2) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (10) 6 ½" squares.	
Fabric I	Cut (3) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (10) 3 ½" x 9 ½"	

strips.

ıbric J	 Cut (2) 3 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (10) 3 ¹/₂" x 6 ¹/₂" strips. Cut (4) 4 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ¹/₂" x 70 ¹/₂" strips. Cut (4) 4 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ¹/₂" x 65 ¹/₂" strips.
lbric K	Cut (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strips into (10) 3 ½" squares.
ıbric L	 Cut (5) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (15) 1 ¹/₂" x 12 ¹/₂" strips. Cut (6) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 1 ¹/₂" x 51 ¹/₂" strips. Cut (4) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 64 ¹/₂" strips. Cut (3) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 53 ¹/₂" strips.

Cut (8) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips for the binding.



Fabric Requirements

Quilt Cutting Directions - Continued

Fabric M	Cut (4) 2 ¹ / ₂ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips	
	together end to end with diagonal	
	seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 66 ½" strips.	
	Cut (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips	
	together end to end with diagonal	
	seams and cut (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ x 57 $\frac{1}{2}$ strips.	


Backing Cut (2) 86" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 73" x 86" backing.

Making the Quilt


Note: The arrows in diagrams represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

Quilt Top Assembly


- Sew (1) 3 ¹/₂" x 5 ¹/₂" Fabric C strip to the left side of (1) 3 ¹/₂" x 5 ¹/₂" Fabric D strip lengthwise. Sew (1) 3 ¹/₂" x 6 ¹/₂" Fabric B strip to the top of the newly sewn strip lengthwise. Sew (1) 6 ¹/₂" x 8 ¹/₂" Fabric A strip to the left side of the newly sewn strip to make the top row (Diagram 1).
- Sew (1) 4 ¹/₂" Fabric E square to the left end of (1) 4 ¹/₂" x 8 ¹/₂" Fabric F strip to make the bottom row (Diagram 1).
- **3.** Sew together the (2) rows from Steps 1-2 lengthwise to make (1) 12 ¹/₂" Block One square (Diagram 1).
- 4. Repeat Steps 1-3 to make (10) Block One squares total.



- **6.** Sew together (1) 6 ¹/₂" Fabric H square, (1) 3 ¹/₂" x 6 ¹/₂" Fabric A strip and (1) 3 ¹/₂" x 6 ¹/₂" Fabric J strip, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make the middle column (Diagram 2).
- Sew (1) 3 ¹/₂" x 9 ¹/₂" Fabric I strip to the top of (1) 3 ¹/₂" Fabric K square to make the right column (Diagram 2).
- **8.** Sew together the (3) columns from Steps 5-7 lengthwise to make (1) 12 ¹/₂" Block Two square (Diagram 2).
- **9.** Repeat Steps 5-8 to make (10) Block Two squares total.



- 10. Refer to Diagram 3 and sew together (2) Block One squares, (3) 1 ¹/₂" x 12 ¹/₂" Fabric L strips and (2) Block Two squares to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three and Row Five.
- Refer to Diagram 3 and sew together (2) Block Two squares, (3) 1 ¹/₂" x 12 ¹/₂" Fabric L strips and (2) Block One squares to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.
- 12. Sew together the (5) Rows in numerical order and (4) 1 ¹/₂" x 51 ¹/₂" Fabric L strips, lengthwise and alternating them from top to bottom, to make the 51 ¹/₂" x 64 ¹/₂" Center Block (Diagram 3).
- Sew (1) 3 ¹/₂" x 6 ¹/₂" Fabric G strip to the top of (1) 3 ¹/₂" x 6 ¹/₂" Fabric B strip to make the left column (Diagram 2).




Quilt Top Assembly (*Refer to the Quilt Layout when assembling the quilt top.*)

- **13.** Sew (1) 1 ¹/₂" x 64 ¹/₂" Fabric L strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ¹/₂" x 53 ¹/₂" Fabric L strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block.
- **14.** Sew (1) 2 ¹/₂" x 66 ¹/₂" Fabric M strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 ¹/₂" x 57 ¹/₂" Fabric M strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block.
- **15.** Sew (1) 4 ¹/₂" x 70 ¹/₂" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4 ¹/₂" x 65 ¹/₂" Fabric J strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

Finishing the Quilt


- **16.** Layer and quilt as desired.
- 17. Sew the (8) Fabric L binding strips together, end to end with a 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- **18.** Bind as desired.
