Sweet and fast, this quick panel quilt will add a touch of spring to any home. Make it in just one day!

Fabric Requirements and Cutting Directions

3865-L	² / ₃ yard (1	full panel) Bunny Panel (quilt center)
Cut (1)	$22\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ ", centering	
*3866-LT	1/4 yard	Blue Bunny Print (Pieced Border)

 $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles Cut (6)

3871-T 3/8 yard Blue Mosaic Print (Inner Border)

1½" x 40½" strips Cut (2) 1½" x 24½" strips Cut (2)

3869-LT **Blue Tulip Print (Borders)** ¹/₄ yard

Cut (5) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

Cut (4) 4½" squares

3135-LY2 **Fat 1/8

38/1-LE 3869-LY Cut (5)	Fat ½8 Fat ½8 2½" x 4½"	Yellow Tulip Print (Pieced Border) rectangles each of above 3 fabrics
1867-N	Fat 1/8	Soft Brown Texture (Pieced Border)
3135-LE	Fat 1/8	Pink Tic Tac Print (Pieced Border)
3135-LT	Fat 1/8	Blue Tic Tac Print (Pieced Border)
3871-LY	Fat 1/8	Yellow Mosaic Print (Pieced Border)
3869-V	Fat 1/8	Olive Tulip Print (Pieced Border)
3870-T	Fat 1/8	Blue Dot (Pieced Border)

Yellow Tic Tac Print (Pieced Border)

3870-LN Fat 1/8 Brown Dot (Pieced Border) Yellow Dot (Pieced Border) 3870-LY Fat 1/8 2½" x 4½" rectangles **each** of above 8 fabrics Cut (6)

3866-LY 3/4 yard Yellow Bunny Print (Outer Border)

4½" x 50½" strips Cut (2) 4½" x 32½" strips Cut (2)

*Additional yardage needed for backing (see below).

**A Fat 1/8th is a 9" x 20-22" cut of fabric.

2⁷/₈ yards Blue Bunny Print (backing) Cut and piece to fit quilt top with 4" overlap on all sides.

3868-LT 5/8 yard Blue/Yellow Stripe (binding)

Cut (6) 2½" x width of fabric strips Quilt finishes 40½" x 58½"

Making the Pieced Borders

1. Referring to Diagram A, stitch (21) 2½" x 4½" rectangles together to make left side pieced border strip. Repeat to make right side border strip. Sew (14) 2½" x 4½" rectangles together to make top border strip. Repeat to make bottom border strip. Sew (2) 2½" x 4½" rectangles together each to make top left and bottom right pieced border squares.



Assembling the Quilt

- 2. Please refer to Quilt Diagram and quilt photo throughout assembly.
- 3. Stitch blue mosaic $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to sides of $22\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ " panel. Sew blue mosaic $24\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to top and bottom.
- 4. Watching orientation, sew pieced side borders to sides. Stitch top left pieced square to left end of top border and sew to top. Stitch bottom right pieced square to right end of bottom border and sew to bottom.
- 5. Sew yellow bunny print 4½" x 50½" strips to sides of quilt. Stitch blue tulip 4½" squares to ends of yellow bunny 4½" x 32½" strips and sew to top and bottom.

Finishing the Quilt

6. Layer quilt with batting and blue bunny print backing. Quilt as desired. Bind with blue/yellow stripe to finish quilt.


